A new shoe brush polisher that has a lamb's wool facing makes a good duster for that quick lick-and-a-promise dusting job that must be done in a few minutes residences in Georgetown & Tavistock, Ont. to be before guests arrive.

The lamb's wool picks up dust, won't scratch and the handle is easier to hold than a dust cloth. Of course, don't use one that has already been used for polishing

Before putting the garden tools away for the winter, clean off any dirt or rust with a steel brush. Stubborn rust can usually be removed by working the tool up and down in a bucket filled with sand which has been saturated with a light car oil or used oil from your car or lawn mower. The oil will help to protect the metal or all metal parts can be sprayed with silicone. If necessary, paint any wooden surfaces. Do this before using the silicone spray. Added protection for metal parts can be done by wrapping in

Using cooking tongs saves time and temper when turning food over in a frying pan or transferring it to a serving dish.

Ladies-Don't discard your old straw purses at the end of the summer. They can be recycled into many practical uses around the home. One such idea is to remove all hinges, sections and other hard ware from the purse.

Line the interior with aluminum foil, adhesive-backed wallpaper or a pretty paper napkin and you will have an ideal container for holding bread, rolls, chips or crackers on the dinner table, cook-out or barbeque.

A rubber tap faucet washer attached with a screw to the inside of a winter casing so it presses lightly against the window sash will help to prevent annoying window rattles yet it will not interfere with raising or lowering the sash.

A sawhorse can quickly be set-up outdoors by using your step ladder and a piece of wide scrap lumber. Place the board through the second step of the ladder so one end rests against the ground and the wall of the house.
