The minor hockey season reaches its climax Sunday when all house-league championships will be on the line at Memorial Arena.

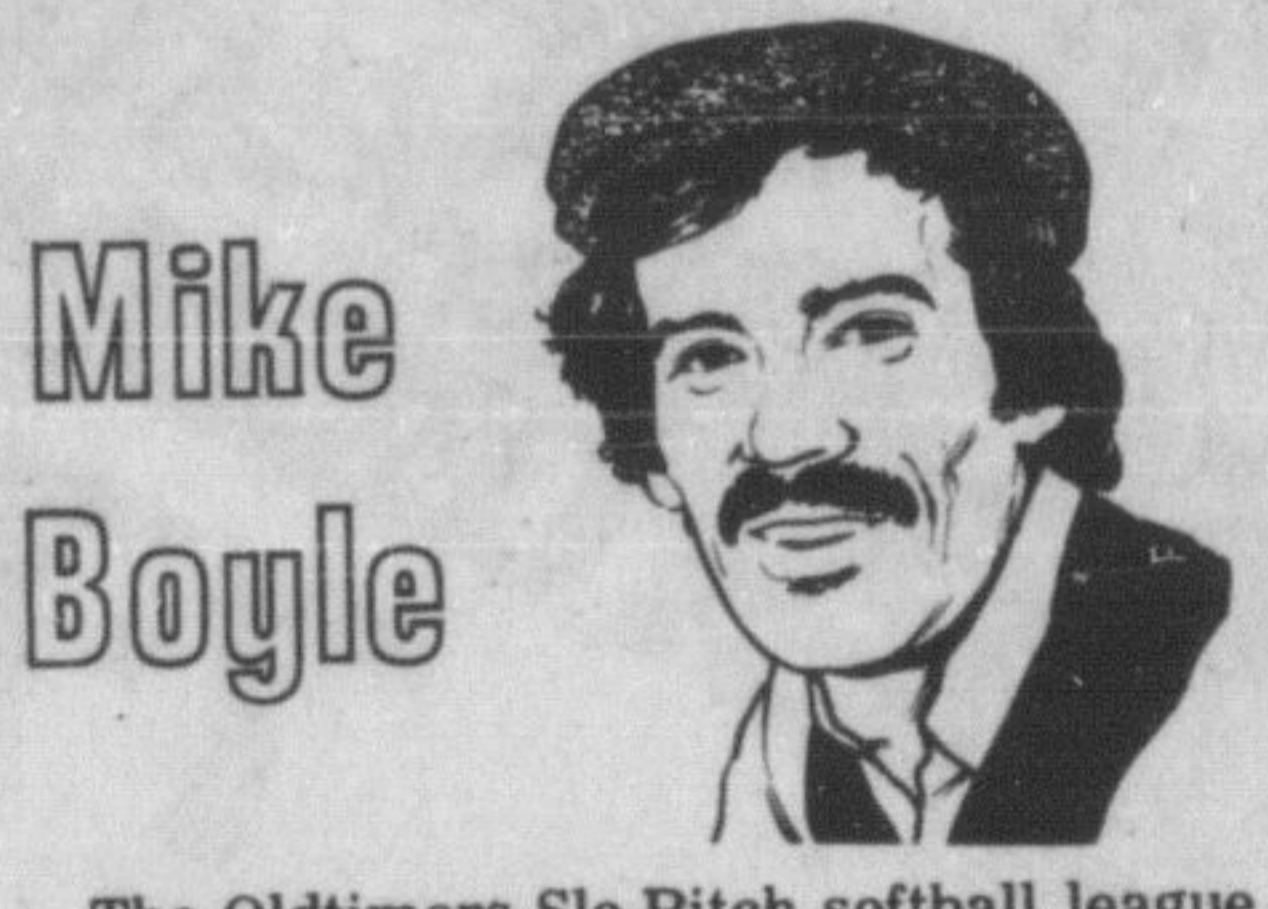
