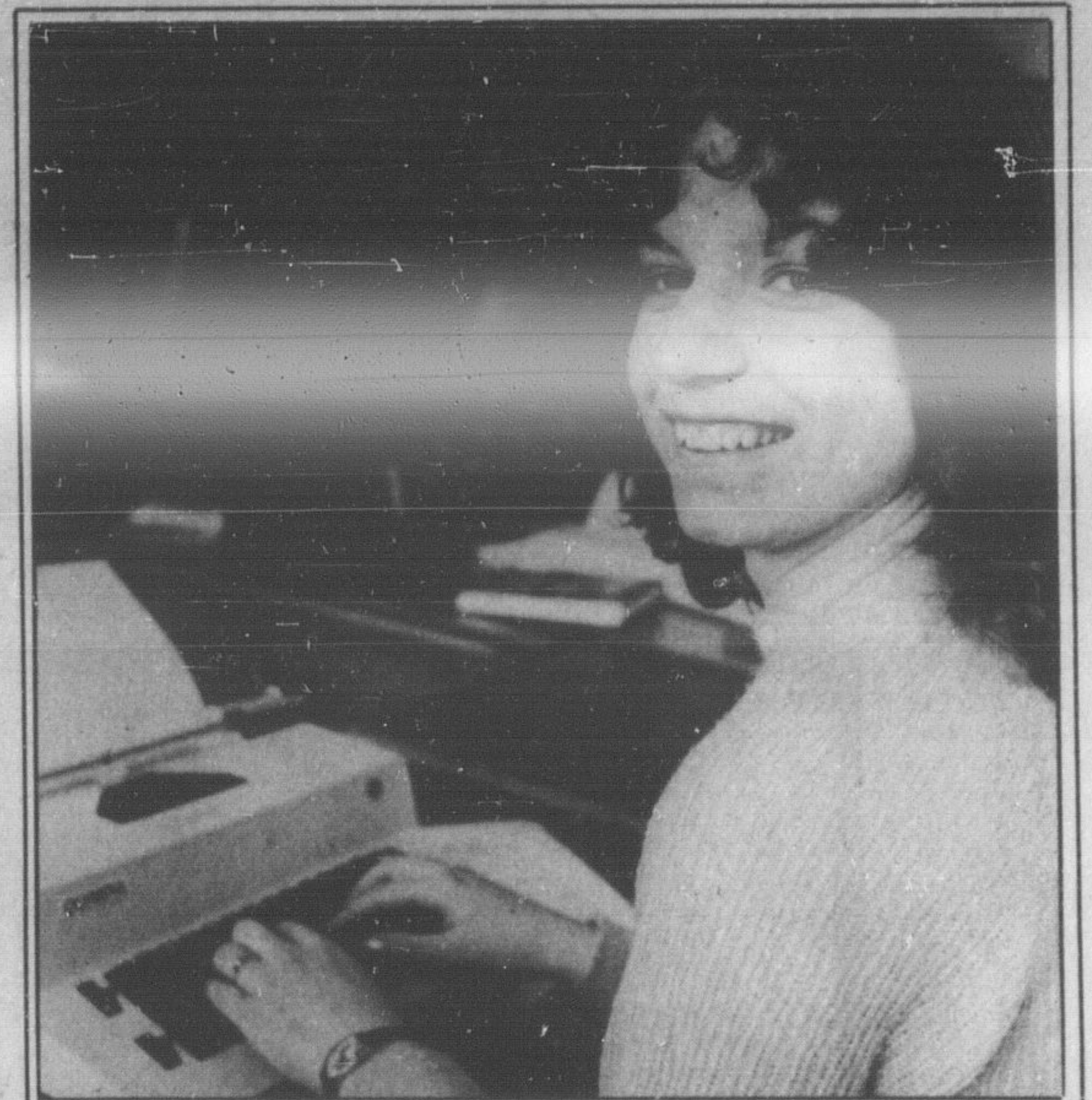

A special day is planned for June 13 at the Agricultural Museum at Milton when the likeness of Mr. Erland Lee, the Women's Institute nominee, will be unveiled in the Ontario Agricultural Hall of Fame along with others who contributed to agriculture in the province. Visitors to the museum during the summer will be able to see and take part in the many special events as well as visit the Women's Institute Hall.

Next week over 550 delegates from all of Ontario will attend an officers conference at Waterloo University to learn new skills in leadership, be informed of the purpose, work and activities of the Women's Institute.

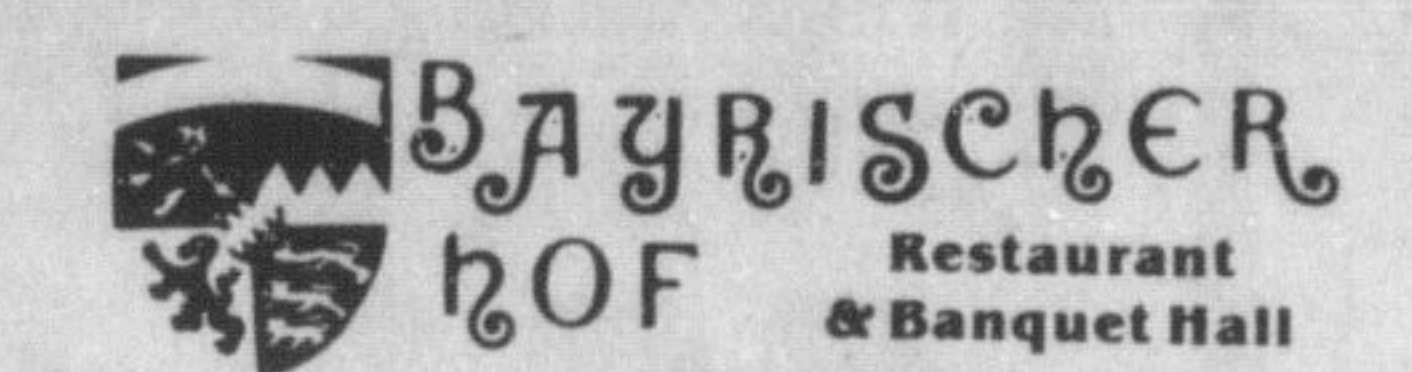
