

Historically severed by a ribbon of steel, Milton will soon by undisturbed by the railway with the completion of the \$5 million underpass at Ontario St. and Main St.

The project, the phase captured here under the auspices of Dagmar Construction of Markham, is ex-

pected to be completed by June 1983.
However, Town staff are confident traffic will be using the underpass by December of this year.

The new line over the bridge will be completed this weekend and will be in use on Monday. But, Miltonians will have to suffer just a little bit more inconvenience before that time.

Main St. between Ninissing Pd.

Main St., between Nipissing Rd. and Wilson Dr. will be closed to through traffic from 7 a.m. Thursday to 8 a.m. Saturday. Traffic will have access on Saturday, but Main St. will be closed again on Sunday while work crews perform the finishing touches on the line.

If you want to get around the closure, remember, Nipissing Rd. joins Main St. with Thompson Rd. However, it is an unassumed road, so be careful.
