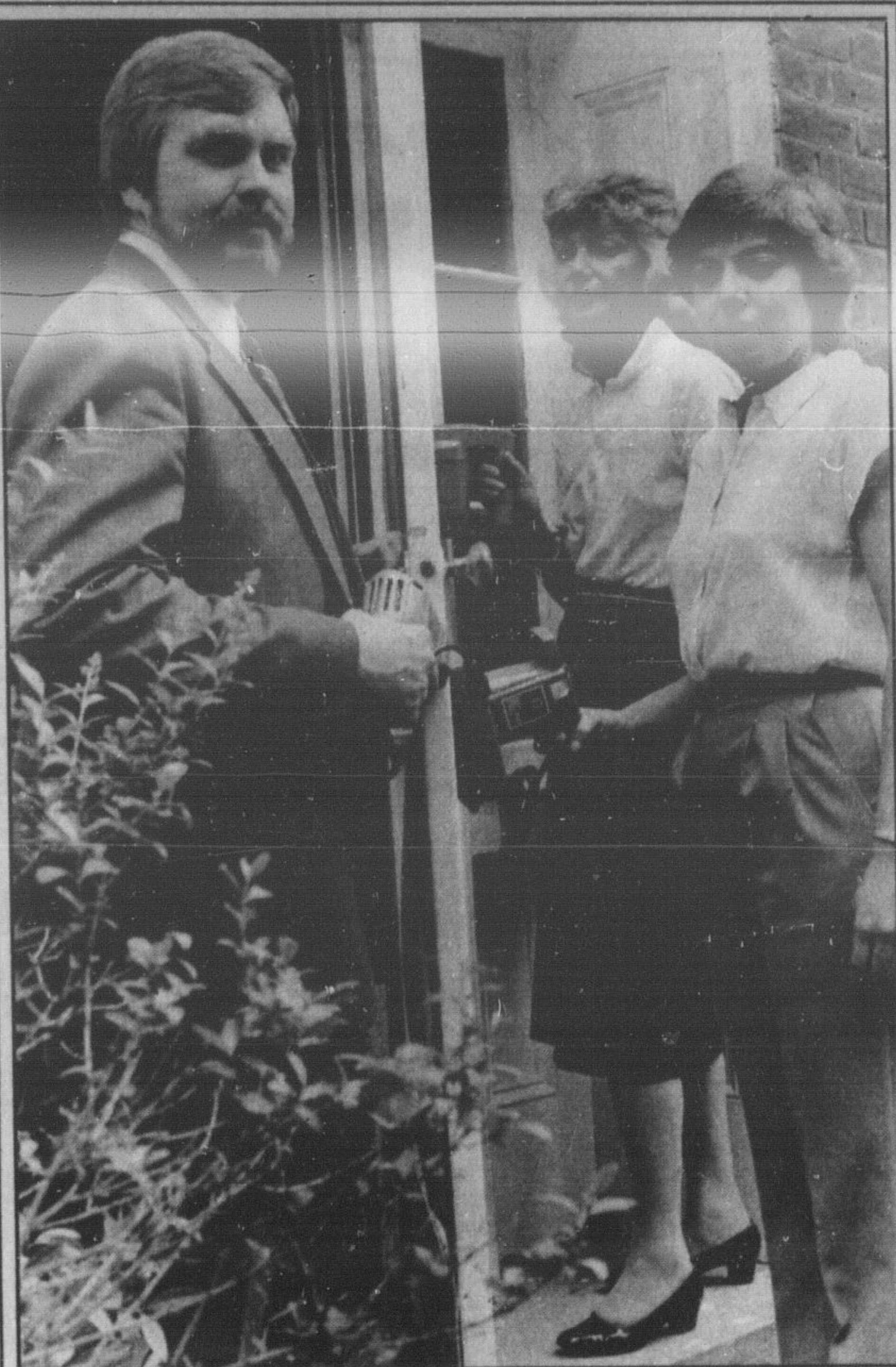

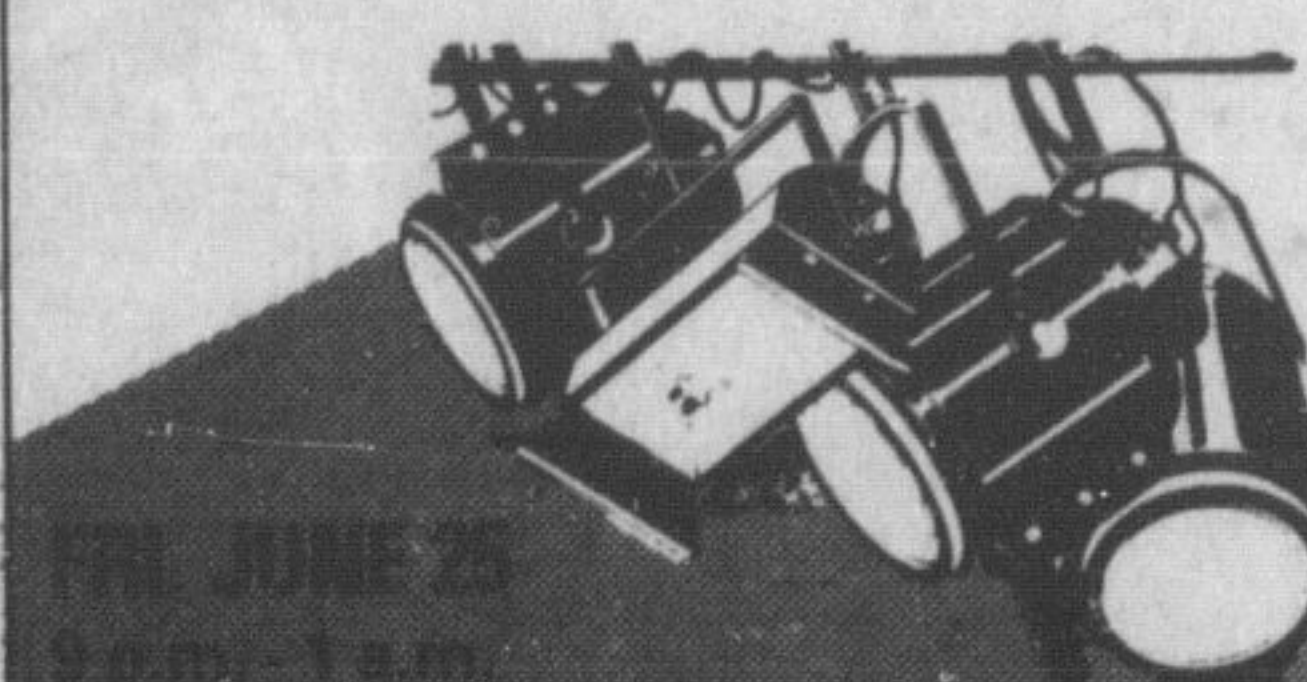

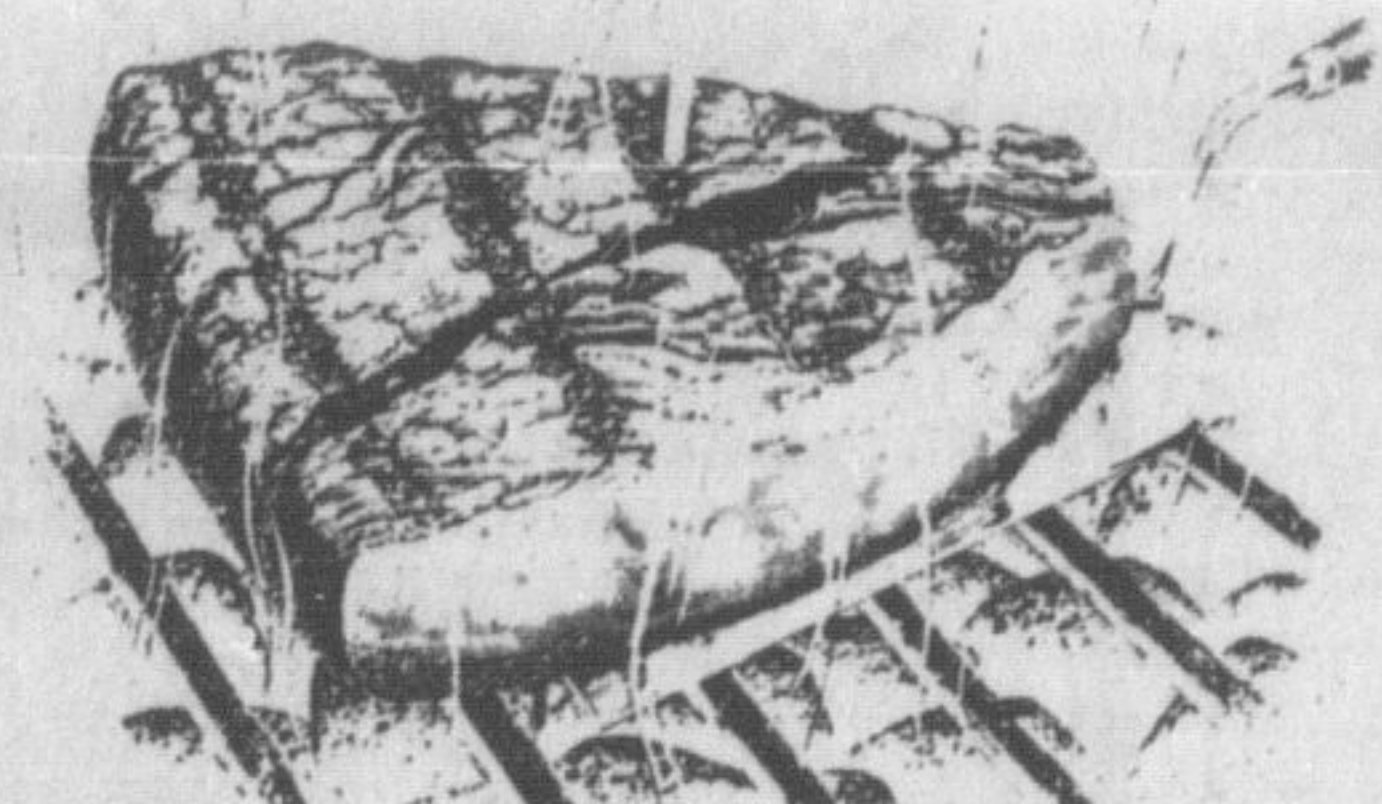

## Propane vehicle nixed

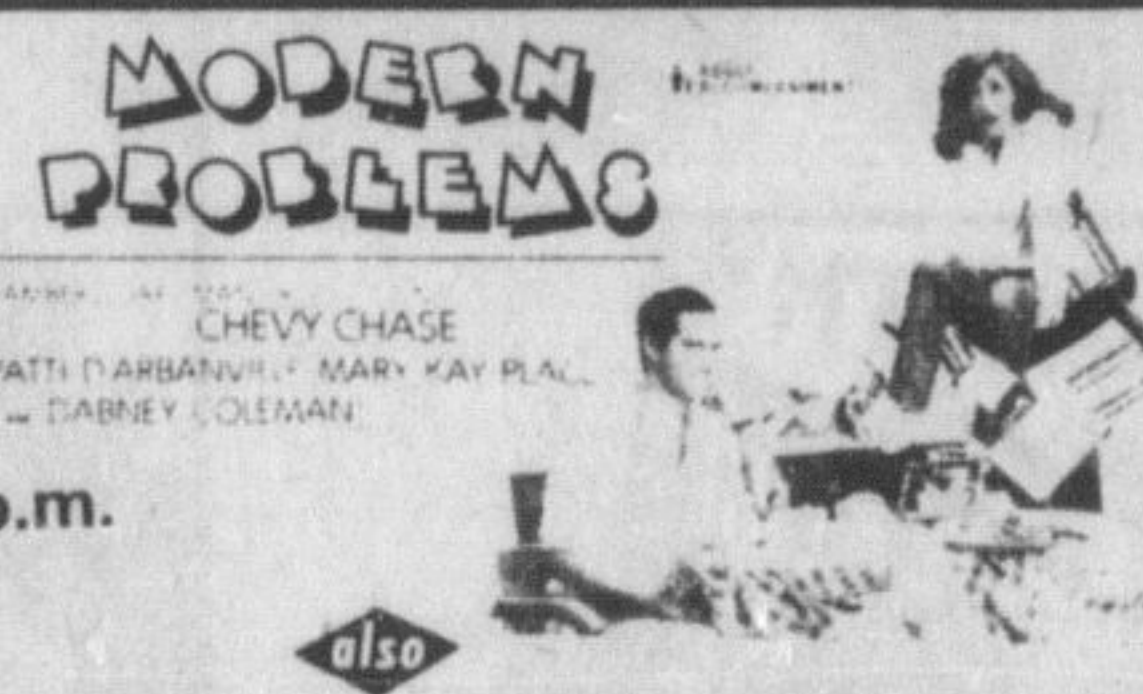
Plans to buy a single propane vehicle for Halton's public works department are a waste of time, members of the administration and finance committee decided last week.

Committee members opted to forego plans by public works director Bob Moore, who wanted a single propane powered vehicle for his department so he could monitor its performance for a year before recommending the purchase of more. Mr. Moore, urged committee members not to accept a recommendation to purchase three propane powered pick-up trucks "because we've already bought one to monitor for a year and in hasn't even been delivered yet."

"I think it would be premature to go with more propane vehicles right now," he added. Other committee members felt the director was taking a much too cautious approach to something that has already been well proven. Oakville Coun. Harry Barrett noted Halton Regional Police have six propane-powered cars now and records suggest they are cheaper to operate than gasoline engines. The Oakville Hydro Commission kept even closer records on the two propane vehicles it operates, he added "and they're going to buy six more."
