


The ADAPT program identifies addiction related problems in their clients, then motivates them to do something about the problem, and

helps to reduce the costly medical and/or hospital care needed for people suffering from the effects of long-term substance abuse, and helps their clients to function more effectively in the community, thus also reducing the social costs (such as police, court, welfare, etc.) of substance abuse. Last year, ADAPT

carried a caseload of 336 clients. Of that number 52 were from the Milton area. The program can only work with residents of the Region of Halton, though they do receive enquiries from Peel and Hamilton, as these regions are not served by this type of program. According to Ian Stewart, Executive Director of ADAPT, the number of referrals they are receiving has skyrocketed with the decline in the economy. He feels that the added stress of financial problems can be enough to stimulate addiction potential problems in individuals. The staff at ADAPT is also doing much more work with youth, having had a great increase in the number of referrals they are receiving in the 16-19 year old age group. Mr. Stewart went on to say that over 50 per cent of their clients are under the age of 30.

Currently, the ADAPT program receives 75 per cent of its funding from the Ministry of Health and the remainder from the Region of Halton, the United Way of Oakville and the United Way of Hamilton-Wentworth and Burlington.
