## Snow creates problem

Last winter's heavier than average snowfall has created a \$40,000 headache for Halton public works officials. Last week members of the planning and public works and administration and finance committees agreed to trim that much from other budgets in the department to cover a deficit. In a report, public works director Bob Moore said the deficit was caused by heavier than average snowfalls during the first three months of this year. The money can be found, he said, in accounts for line painting and road patching where less work was required this year than expected. "This seems like an appropriate way to deal with the problem," commented Burlington Coun. Jim Grieve.
