1/2 cup thinly sliced onion rings 1 tablespoon flour 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/4 teasponn peper 1 2 3 cups undiluted evaporated

4 beaten eggs Crumble bacon in unbaked pastry shell. Cover with cheese and onion slices. Combine flour, salt and pepper. Gradually add evaporated Milk. Add beaten eggs to evaporated milk mixture; blend well. Pour into pastry shell. Bake in moderate oven (375 degrees F.) 30 to 40 minutes, or until knife inserted near centre comes out clean. Let stand 5 minutes

before serving.
