Unemployment Insurance

There are regulations

If you think there are a lot of regulations and counter-regulations to getting unemployment insurance, you're right.

The amount each person can claim and the length of claim are highly individualized and to an extent localized, said Bob Sutton, public relations officer for the unemployment insurance commission.

Because of this individuality and confusion, people occasionally feel they are being "cheated" by the commission or at the very least "misinformed.'

In order to claim, you must have 10 weeks work under your belt within the past year. This entitles you to 10 weeks benefits at 60 per cent of your average week's earnings in the past 20 weeks to a maximum of \$210.

The longest term you can collect under current

regulations is 50 weeks. You get 25 weeks based on having worked 25 weeks in the previous 52. An additional week is granted for each two weeks worked beyond 26, said Mr. Sutton. This brings the total to 38 weeks.

The final 12 weeks are given at the rate of one week for each half percentage point of unemployment in your area above four per cent. An press will produce unemployment rate of seven per cent would yield sweet cider which will the additional 12 weeks.



in your two-week waiting period (only exempted for special severance situations) then got a job and worked nine weeks before being laid off again, you would be entitled to 41 weeks of insurance but would have no further waiting period, explained

Although by working you have shortened your claim by nine weeks, you have accumulated more work time to be put toward the next claim you make, he said.

If however, you earned money at a higher rate during those nine weeks, you may wish to renew your claim to take advantage of that in your pay-

A claim which is set up but not drawn on, can run out. But if you are working, you would probably have accumulated enough to renew the claim for a period equal to the original.

While claiming, you can work and earn money up to 25 per cent of your unemployment payments without those being affected. Beyond, that, the amounts will be deducted from UIC benefits.

The maternity unemployment insurance claim was set up subsequent to the original program, said Mr. Surron.

To qualify here, the commission calculates 30 weeks back from the expected due date, then checks the 20 weeks prior.

For a claim, the applicant must have been attached to the work force or claiming unemployment insurance for 10 of them.
