# Costs down

Governments are often accused of overspending, however that cannot be the case when referring to 1982 municipal election expenses.

The costs in Milton came to about \$6,500 below budget at approximately \$37,000. The final figure is not established as some additional expenses including those for the inaugural meeting, are still outstanding.

Clerk co-ordinator Roy Main attributes the lower than expected cost to "excellent prices" received for printing.

Mr. Main reported to the returned Milton council that the 1982 election cost 15 per cent more than the 1980 effort.

"It is significant that costs were held well below estimate in that several additional polls were added which required additional personnel, the voter's list expanded by approximately 3,000 electors, a new computer program was required and additional supplies were required such as election stickers," he stated in his report.

Councillors decided the "I voted I care" stickers were a positive idea and asked that one be forwarded to the provincial government.

In Milton, just more than 35 per cent of the electorate turned up at the polling stations.

The inaugural meeting of Milton council, open to the public, is scheduled for Monday, Dec. 6 at 7.30 p.m.
