Region needs anniversary review - Bird

After 10 years, the time has come for a complete review of regional government, according to Halton's administration and finance committee.

Acting on a recommendation from Burlington Mayor Roly Bird, committee members agreed last week to ask for a review of the concept of

regional government.

Similar requests have been rejected in the past, but Mr. Bird said his idea is different this time.

"I'm not looking for an operational review of this region alone," he told committee members.

"I'm talking about a review of the concept of regional government and

what has happened to it in the last 10 years."

He added such a review would help regional officials identify the trend they see toward less provincial financing for local government.

"I don't think regional government is going to go away," he said. "I think it's going to stay with us and we are going to have to learn to live with it."

"I also think the more efficient we become the less support we are going to get from the province," he added.

Halton Region, along with several others, is finishing the tenth year of its operations this year. The first regional council was inaugurated in January 1974, but the first meetings of the new group were held in October, 1973.

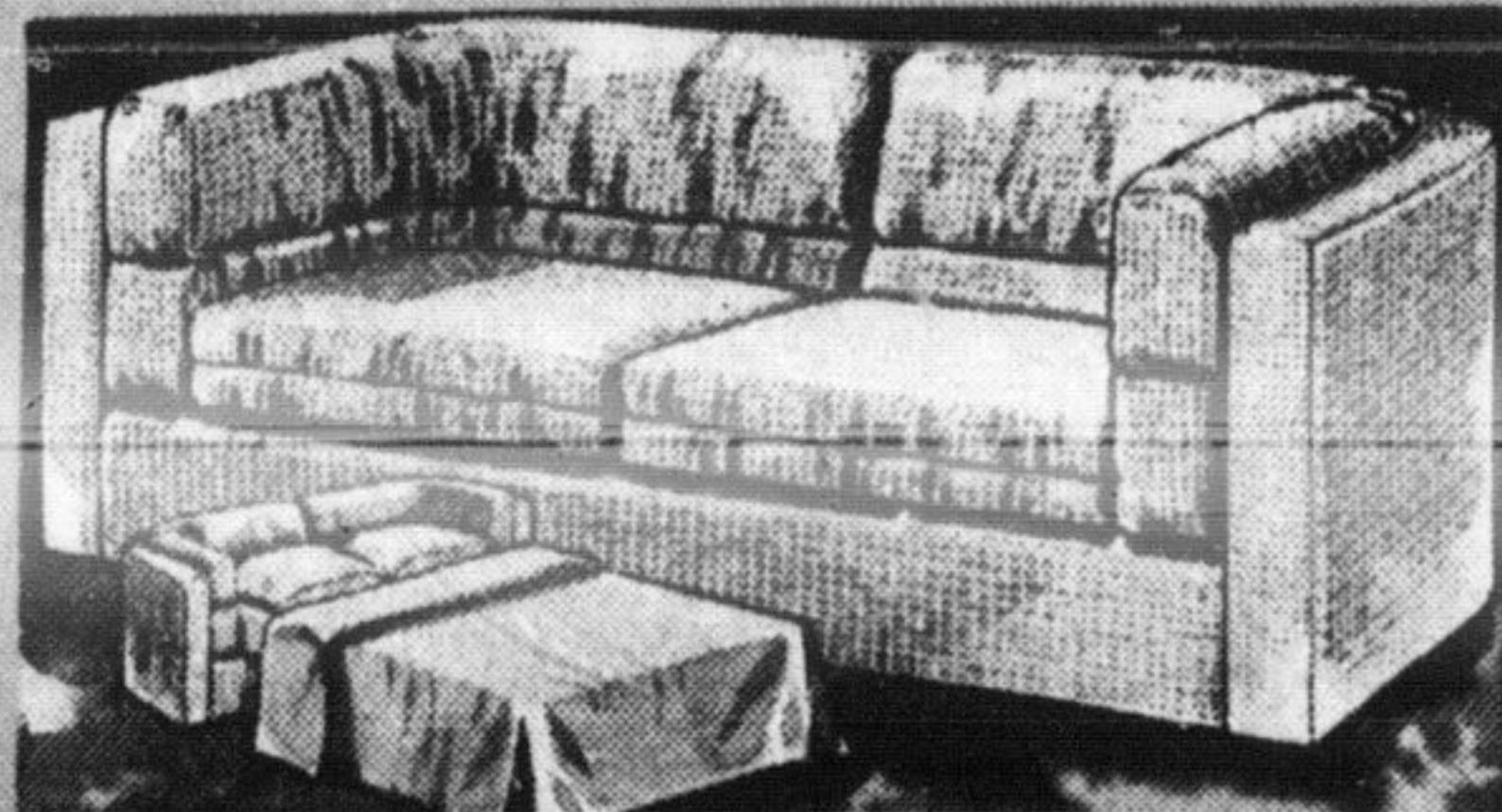

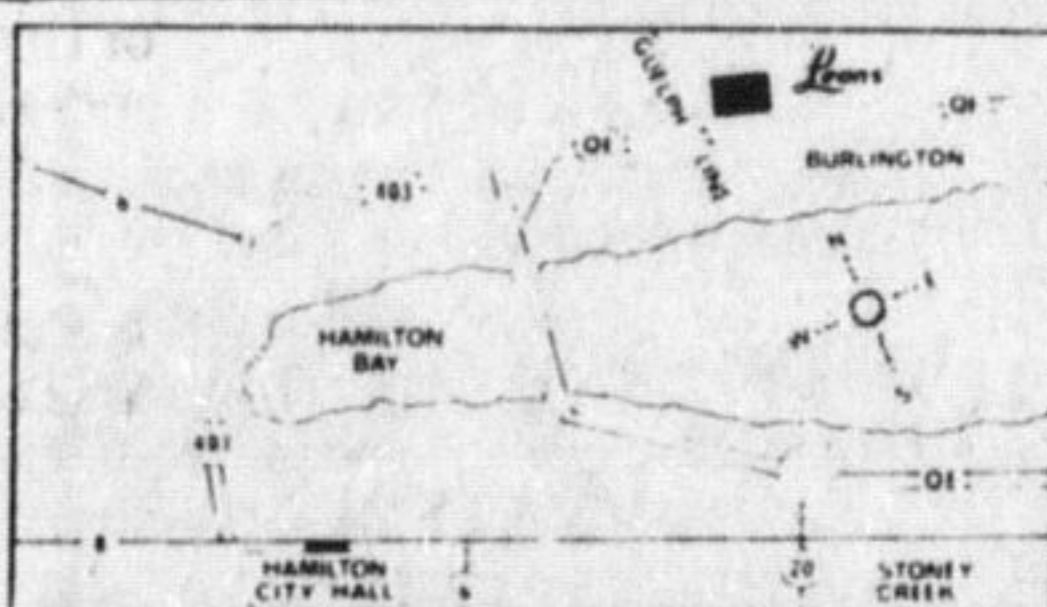

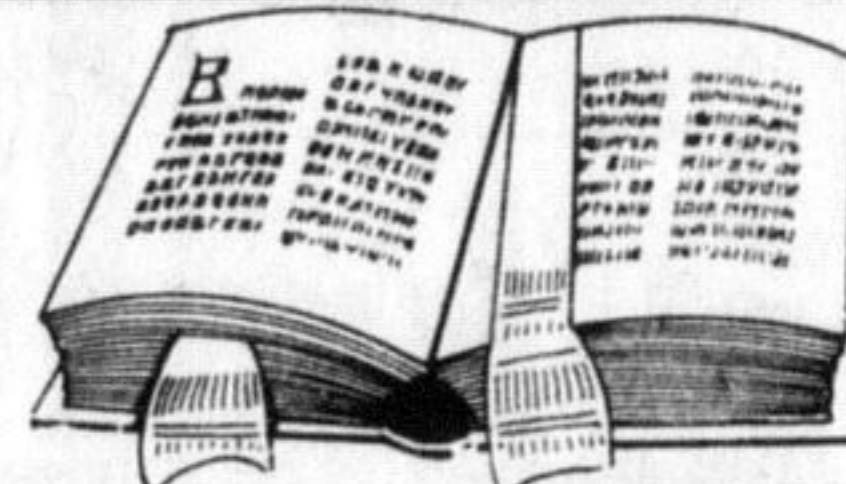
