## Children are hurt in Monday crash

Halton Regional Police are asking for assistance in their investigation of a two car crash early Monday evening.

Nine people, five of them children, suffered injuries in the collision which occurred at Derry Rd. and Hwy. 25 at 6 p.m. Nabil Sakka six years, of Toronto and his sister Layla, four years, were both transferred to the Hospital for Sick Children by helicopter from Milton District Hospital.

The two were the most critically injured in the accident and suffered serious head injuries.

The pair were passengers in a car driven by Zeyad Sakka of 3175 Kerwin Ave., Toronto. He, along with his wife Hanna Sakka, were treated for minor

injuries at Milton District Hospital.

Three other children of the same address, also passengers in the car, received minor injuries:

The were; Lena Sakka 13 years, Lama Sakka two years, and Yasmin Sakka 11 years.

The second vehicle involved was driven by 25-year-old Bryon Pyne of 6540 Falconer Dr., Streetsville.

Two passengers in that car, Elizabeth Pyne, wife of the driver, and Eric Moore 25, of 10 King High Dr., Thornhill received minor knee injuries.

Police are asking anyone who may have witnessed the accident and have not already spoken with police to call 878-5511.

## Region study plea rejected

A comprehensive cost-benefit analysis of regional government in Ontario will not be carried out.

Claude Bennett, provincial Minister of Municipal affairs and housing, delivered that verdict recently in a letter to regional chairman Jack Raftis.

Mr. Bennett was responding to a regional council request for an in-depth review of the operation of regional governments in the province 10 years after many of them were created.

That resolution was passed during a debate on the value of arranging some form of anniversary celebration marking the end of the region's first decade.

Burlington Mayor Roly Bird was responsible for that resolution. Last week he noted again local taxpayers can expect the costs of government to rise because of provincial action.

Mr. Bird said such a study would have provided the minister with "a chance to say something about the benefits of regional government, because there have been some."

"I don't think we've taken over the same burden of costs the board of education has," he said, "but we can see the tremendous amount of money we've spent over the last 10 years and what we'll have to spend in the current trend continues."
