

## Region study plea rejected

A comprehensive cost-benefit analysis of regional government in Ontario will not be carried out.

Claude Bennett, provincial Minister of Municipal affairs and housing, delivered that verdict recently in a letter to regional chairman Jack Raftis.

Mr. Bennett was responding to a regional council request for an in-depth review of the operation of regional governments in the province 10 years after many of them were created.

That resolution was passed during a debate on the value of arranging some form of anniversary celebration marking the end of the region's fist decade. Burlington Mayor Roly Bird was respon-

sible for that resolution. Last week he noted again local taxpayers can expect the costs of government to rise because of provincial action. Mr. Bird said such a study would have

provided the minister with "a chance to say something about the benefits of regional government, because there have been some."

"I don't think we've taken over the same burden of costs the board of education has," he said, "but we can see the tremendous amount of money we've spent over the last 10 years and what we'll have to spend in the current trend continues."
