

Bob Brechin says 'bye at Halton council

Burlington's Bob Brechin bid adieu to his political career at last week's meeting of Halton council.

The two-term regional councillor had also served 19 years on Burlington council. He said farewell in as many languages as he could muster and offered advice to those councillors who will continue.

"I will not stand for any office," said Mr. Brechin. "I haven't always agreed with everyone but I enjoyed working with you." He told council to always be practical, make fair decisions not for political gain, and to refrain from playing to the fees at 10 local museums and art galleries
