jump (personal best of 3:78m) and open 80m hurdles (18.5s) as well as bronze in the 100m (personal best of 16.3s).


Garrett Lyall, 12, struck gold in his first meet, capturing the shot distance events. She won both the put open boys title with a 10.22m


throw. Silver medals in both the 200m (personal best of 28.9s) and 400m (personal best of 1:08) were among his other accomplishments..


