Arrest in robbery at local store

A man is in custody after a grocery store manager was abducted, robbed and locked in a walk-in freezer Tuesday night.

The 39-year-old manager of Super Choice Country Market on Derry Road had just left work and was driving east-bound on Derry Road when he was hit from behind near Trafalgar Road at 9:20 p.m.

He pulled onto the shoulder to sort out the collision and went to talk to the driver who had slightly bumped the rear of his car.

However, three occupants of the other vehicle grabbed the manager and forced him into their car, Halton Regional Police said.

They returned him to work and made him open the store, said Halton police spokesman Sgt. Frank Phillips.

Inside, they forced the manager to unlock the safe and the culprits removed an undisclosed amount of money.

In the process of tying the manager up, the trio got nervous when they saw a patrolling police car pass by the store, said Det. Sgt. Ron Welsh.

They quickly put a rope around the victim's neck, locked him in a walk-in freezer and fled.

Luckily, the manager found a way to free himself and immediately called police, Sgt. Phillips said.

The culprits told the victim they were armed, but no weapon was produced, Det. Sgt. Welsh said.

The manager recognized one of the culprits as being a former employee of the store, he said.

Metropolitan Toronto Police had arrested a man in connection with the robbery at press time yesterday and charges by Halton police were pending.

Police are looking for two other suspects described as black males in their late teens. They were driving a small blue car.

Halton candidates can spend \$66,000

Halton candidates in this federal election are eligible to spend only \$66,575.01.

Figures for all of Canada's 301 ridings were recently released. The amounts are based on the number of voters and the geography of each riding.

The four Prince Edward Island ridings have the lowest spending limits. All are in the \$49,000 range. The riding with the highest limit is Peace River in Alberta, at \$78,589.58, followed by Pontiac-Gatineau-Labelle in Quebec at \$78,293.39 and Vancouver Island North at \$77,244.11.

The federal election is slated for Monday, June 2.
