Pelz still miffed about Bell School Line

Phase Two of reconstruction on hold

Bell School Line reconstruction opponent Don Pelz kept the fire of his discontent smoldering at Monday's meeting of town council's general committee.

Some councillors let their exasperation show through. At times the discussion came close to boiling over.

Mr. Pelz, a Bell School Line resident for 23 years, has opposed reconstruction of that roadway since the project was proposed some five years ago.

On Monday council was poised to give its blessing to the final phase of the plan but will reconsider options based on Mr. Pelz concerns.

Mr. Pelz complained that runoff water is being funnelled across Bell School Line

through his property, and then back out to the road. He asked that ditching be included in the reconstruction to alleviate the problem, which he claimed causes substantial crop damage.

John Matthews, Milton's director of public works, said that the water is funnelled through the area by a natural swale. Mr. Pelz agreed the watercourse only exists during spring runoff or after particularly heavy rains.

He contended that a ditch, dug by residents across the street, who previously owned both lots, is the main source of the excess water.

"You are saying this ditch was dug by the previous owner, so the problem has existed for 23 years," said Councillor Brian Penman.

Mr. Pelz waved around pictures and a

copy of Milton's official plan as his evidence that the drainage pattern was not natural. He made a thinly veiled threat to sue if his concerns were not addressed.

"You have been here on this project for five years now and this has never been raised," said Councillor John Challinor.
