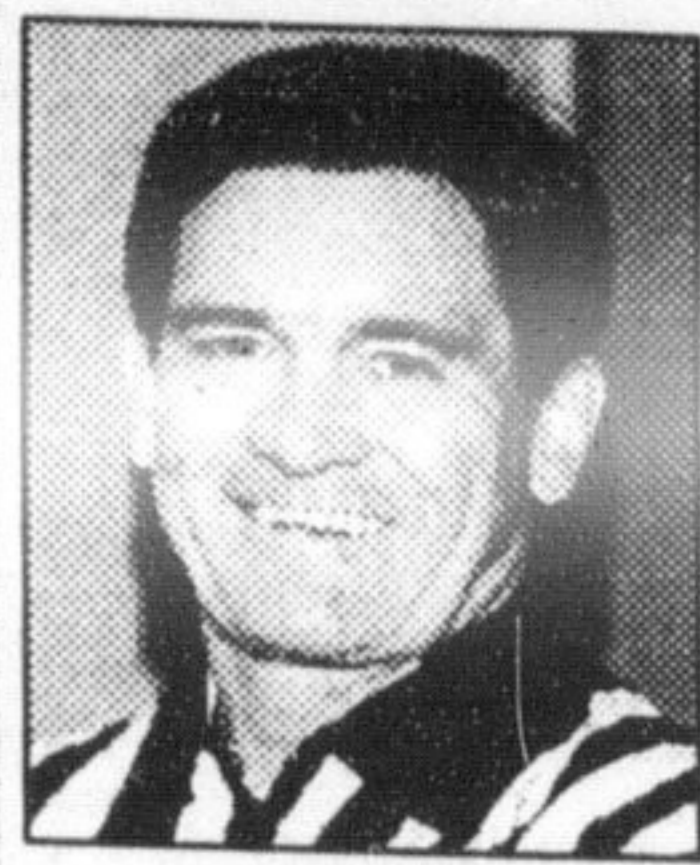

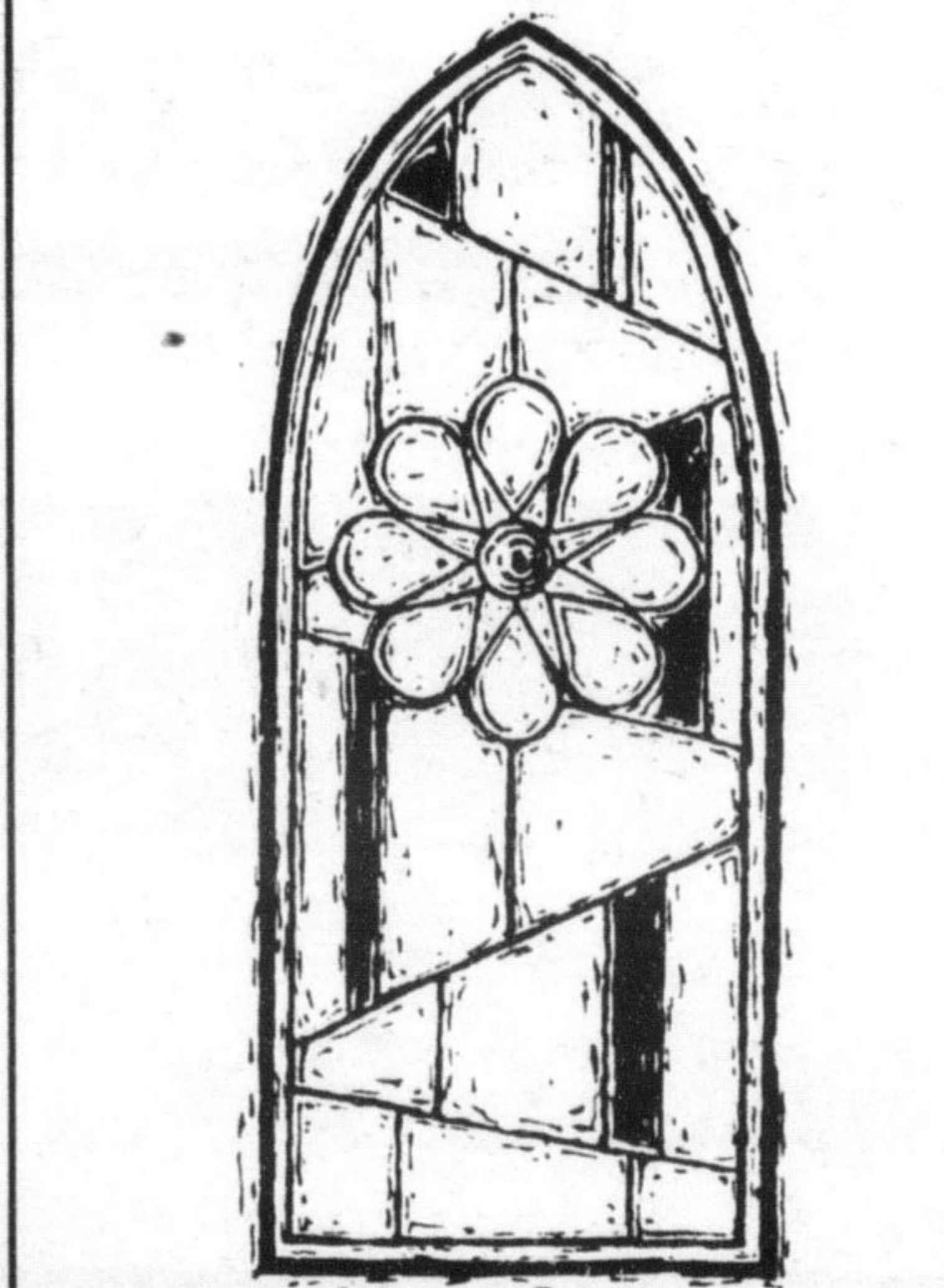
Emily Riding, 3, managed to chase down this donut during the Martin Street School Spring Fling fun day at the school last weekend.
