PRESIDENT'S REPORT



On May 6, 1997, I had the opportunity, on behalf of the Chamber of Commerce, to participate in an interesting new initiative of The Learning Partnership. The Principal/Community Leader for a Day program was established with the following objectives.

- Share ideas and develop linkages between school and community
- Heighten community awareness of the diversity of talent in our students (our future leaders)
- Create opportunities for building strong relationships and partnerships between the community and the education system
- Share ideas on leadership, management techniques and effectiveness of organizations

My participation in this program was a thoroughly rewarding experience. This exchange helped me to gain some insight into what our schools are really like today and to identify with what takes place in the course of a typical day.
