

Someone trying to lend a hand to people in distress in southeast Milton found out the hard way how some will take advantage of the good will of others.

At 7:45 p.m., Monday, June 16, a man was stopped for the traffic light on Trafalgar Road at Burnhamthorpe Road when he was approached by a trio of people claiming their car had broken down.

They asked for help, and for the victim to follow them to their car. The man followed them up a laneway off Trafalgar Road near Lower Base and was confronted by the group who demanded cash and his jewelry.

The complainant tried to run, but was threatened by two members of the group, who held a baseball bat and a metal rod.

The car used by the suspects was described as an older model four-door light green compact with rust on the trunk.




