

Knox Church hoping to move project ahead

The Knox Presbyterian Church group, which is pursuing the construction of a seniors' home, has laid down several layers of plans for the foundation of their project.

However, Karl Reichert, representing the group, said there are some stumbling blocks to overcome before actual construction can begin.

The group, now calling itself Milton Millennium Residences, is trying to secure approximately five acres in the northwest section of the Allendale campus at Ontario Street and Child's Drive.

They are proposing a 120-unit building as a first-phase project, which they estimate will cost \$10 million to construct.

The home would provide residences for seniors who need some assistance with day-to-day living.

The group has secured a project manager and architect. They will soon produce a business plan and make a proposal to Halton Region, which currently owns the land.

Regional officials have made it clear they intend to use any money they can make on the land at Allendale to refurbish Martin House, a holdover from the Halton Centennial Manor.

"Ten million dollars is a lot of money," said Milton Mayor Gord Krantz. "What may or may not evolve will hinge around that land owned by the region."

Mr. Reichert said he would be making a presentation to Halton's health and social

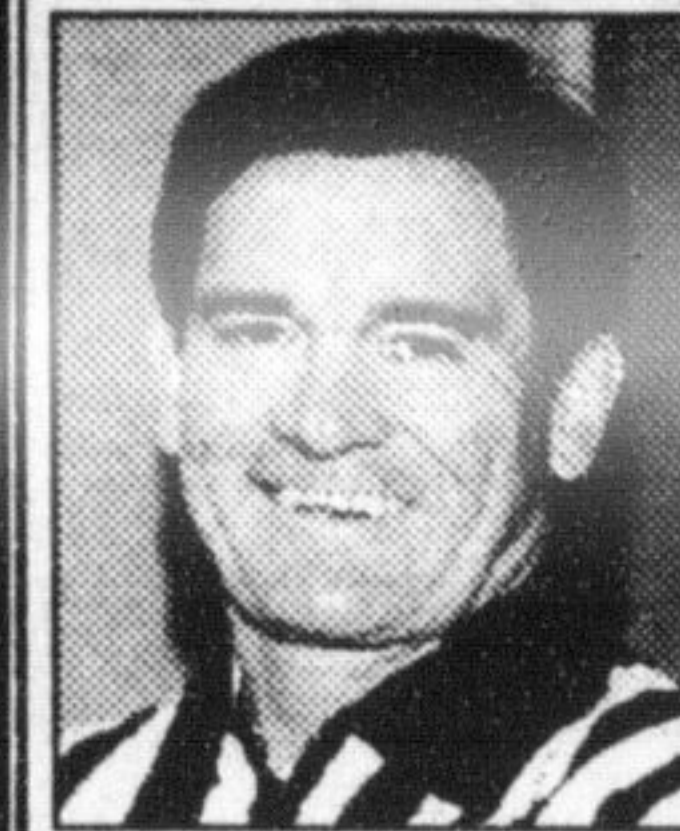

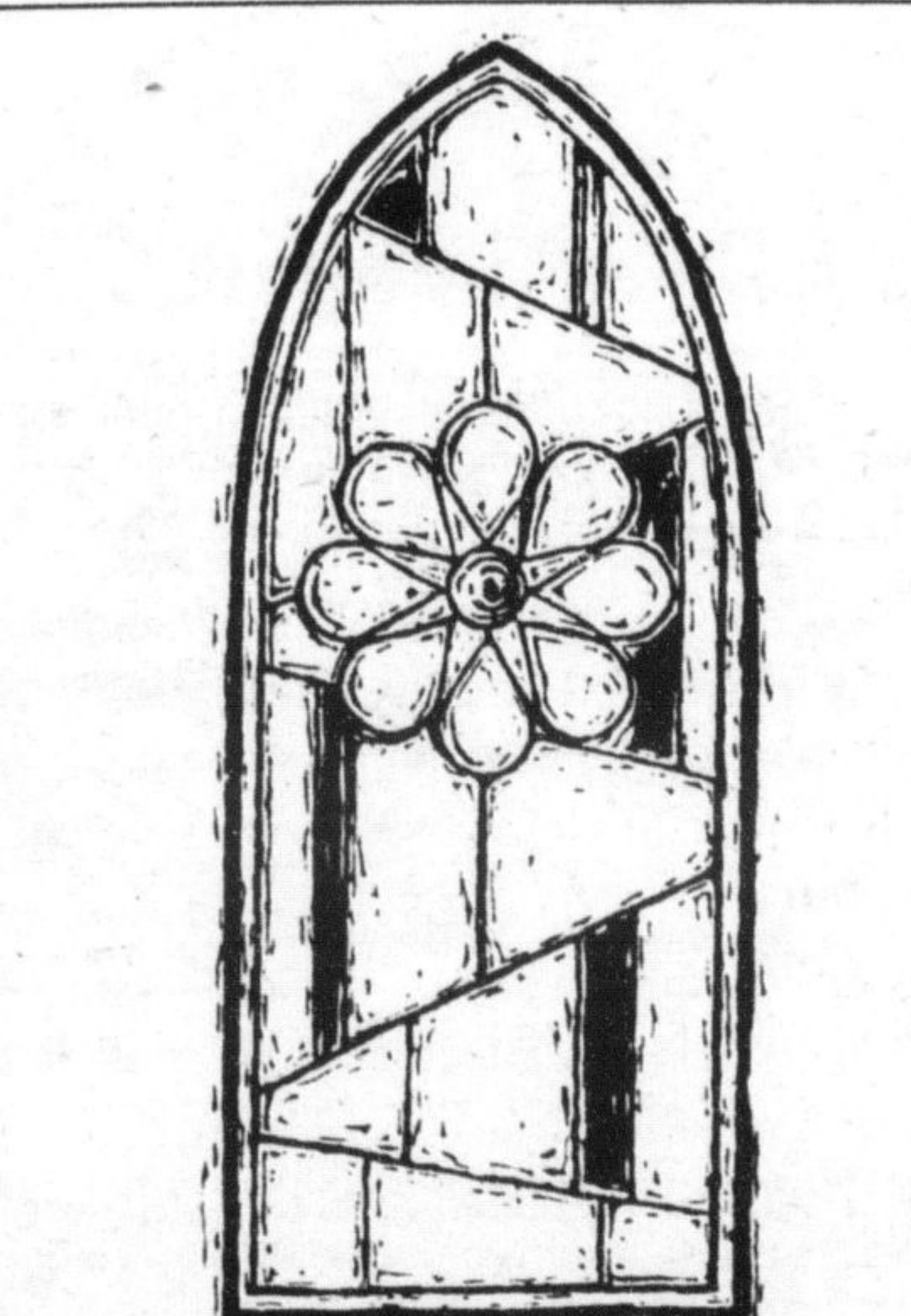
