The Ontario Lacrosse Association presents the OLA Celebrity Lacrosse Challenge Saturday, July 26 at the Oshawa Civic Auditorium.

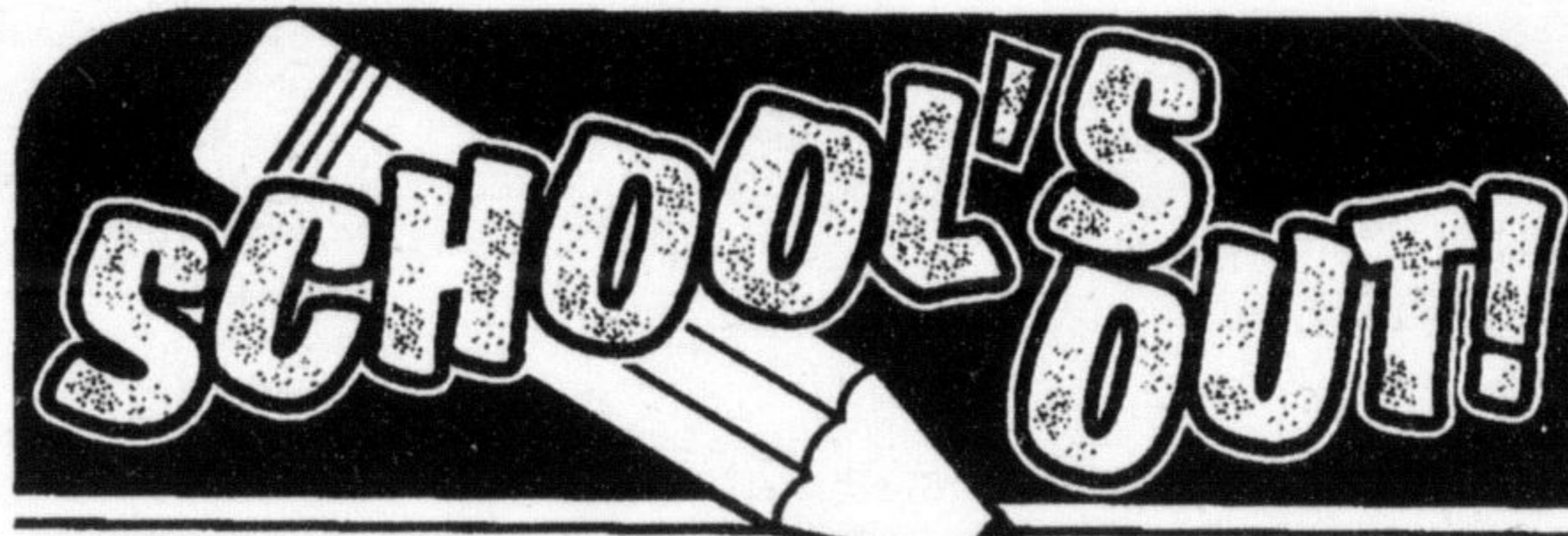
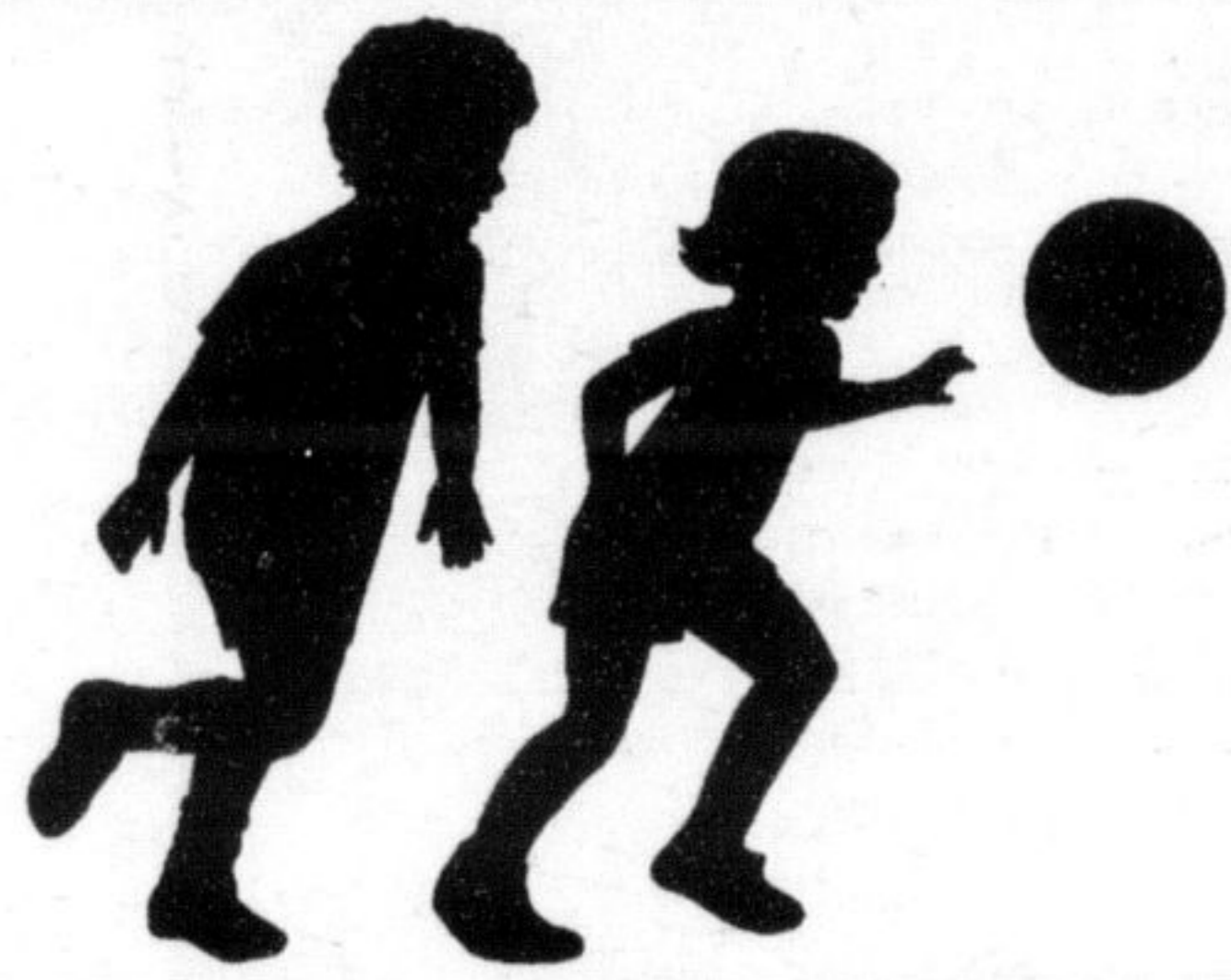
