

Trailer, wood gone

Someone took \$40,000 worth of lumber from a lot in east Milton. Crime Stoppers wants to know where it went and who took it.

At noon on Saturday, June 21, a flat-bed trailer fully loaded with lumber was parked at the Truck Stop on Trafalgar Road near Hwy. 401.

When the driver parked the trailer, a locking device was attached to the fifth wheel pin. Upon his return at nine the following morning, the trailer and its load were both missing.

The five-axle trailer was a navy blue Tita flat-bed with DN Campbell Trucking written on the front headboard. It was loaded with 28 lifts (bundles) of 1 x 6, 2 x 4, and 2 x 6 lumber.

The combined value of the trailer and the wood was estimated at \$75,000.


