Hornby residents worried about latest proposed firm

Rural south Milton residents, already hit with several questionable land uses, warned councillors to proceed carefully on the latest request.

Council tentatively approved a plan for a topsoil blending operation on Sixth Line, south of Lower Base Line.

The approval comes with some conditions, including a requirement to post a bond in the event roads need repair due to heavy traffic, and a monitoring of the construction plans.

Sixth Line resident Peter West said locals had never been properly notified of the application, likely because even the closest residents live outside the 120-meter notification zone.

Mr. West predicted the road would never stand up to the heavy truck traffic required by the topsoil blending operation.

"I intend to hold the mayor and councillors accountable for not following the notification process, and allowing extra tonnage on those roads," Mr. West told council. "If I have annoyed council you should look at what we in Hornby have had to put up with."

He pointed to Eugene Cummins' farm, where dumping was allowed to occur, Scott's Farm, where problems with a composting operation caused severe odours, and the Rhada Soami Society Beas so-called 'barn', a structure which opponents say is intended to be a large-scale meeting hall.

According to a report by municipal staff the operation will not include a retail segment, nor will there be any composting on the site. In addition, Mel Iovio, Milton's director of planning, said that in the rural

area the notification zone is 300 meters, extended from 120 meters in the urban area.

Area councillor Rick Day took some umbrage at suggestions that council has slipped on the Cummins dump, Scott's Composting or the Rhada Soami Society Beas 'barn'. He said council reacted in each case and was able to secure modifications in plans to satisfy local concerns.

Mr. West was not mollified, warning Mr. Day, "We may lose this battle but we will win the war at the next election."

Mr. Day said notification distances in the rural area were extended at his request.

"We have spent countless hours and thousands of dollars of taxpayers' money fighting problems with some degree of success," Mr. Day said.

Councillor John Challinor agreed, saying council has a track record of fixing problems when they arise and following up with documentation to prevent them in the future.

Councillor Colin Best suggested a site monitoring committee be appointed. Council agreed.
