Shift premature, Halton officials say

Councillor Barry Quinn.
"The province is going back on a promise not to transfer Highway 5 until after the completion of Highway 407."

Ms Savoline directed public works staff to search the minutes of various meetings with provincial officials to find a confirmation of that promise.

"There is one major bridge structure on Highway 5, the high level bridge, and several smaller ones, that are about what, about 60 years old?" she asked.

"We're taking over a liability that we don't know anything about."

Pointing to Mississauga development, Burlington Councillor Bob Brechin said he was not opposed to taking control of Highway 5 as long as the Region was able to control the land use planning on either side of the road.

The Region will receive almost \$11 million from the province in transfer funds. Regional officials told councillors that

the province has the right to unilaterally transfer road responsibility, which limits the room for negotiation.

Campers five to 13-years-old will learn how to manage asthma in a fun-filled setting, with emphasis not only on education but outdoor recreation as well.
