



However, this year members scrambled to make the trip by holding several fundraising events and contributing money from their own pockets, she said.

The band members competed and practised frequently in Scotland over the 19-day trip, with little free time.

The victory was particularly rewarding, Ms Brown said, because the group only started competing in the grade 3 category this year.

A group from British Columbia had won in 1995 and 1996, but were unable to make it three in a row.

She attributed Canada's success at the competition to many talented pipers who immigrated from Scotland.

Ms Brown said she was taught by a Scottish master piper at the age of 13 and has passed his knowledge on to her students.

The band brought home the world championship cup, but must return it for next year's competition. Permanently, they were given a quich — a trophy shaped in the form of a drinking vessel — which sits on Ms Brown's mantel.

Those wishing to see the band in action can do so right in their own living rooms next week. The group will perform on Global Television's new show 'First Up' Tuesday at noon.

Ms Brown said the band will be featured at the beginning of the show.
