

# Fans see Cam Fella lead parade once again

Ideal weather conditions and a large, appreciative Saturday evening crowd greeted the legendary Cam Fella, four of his sons, and four divisions of the Nassagaweya Stakes for two-year-old pacing colts at Mohawk Raceway.

In the first division, John Campbell rallied Bear Dance for his second move of the race and he responded through the stretch to edge pace-setter Northern Dynasty by a head in 1:55.

Rustler Hanover continued to build on his upset victory in the Metro Pace in the second division. With Paul MacDonell aboard, the son of Western Hanover was on top at every call, breezing to a four-and-a-half length victory in 1:53.2.

The Bill Wellwood co-owned and trained prodigy has now banked a handsome \$375,199 this season.

Still, as impressive as they were, the Nassagaweya colts worked the card in the shadow of one of their predecessors. The great Cam Fella, now 18 and looking 15 years younger, stirred up memories from the past while on hand to meet and greet fans.

Memphis Flash was back on track in the third Nassagaweya division. The Jate Lobell colt flashed the form which made him a Metro Pace elimination winner three weeks ago. Driver Randy Waples of Hornby eased him out from behind Key To Life in the stretch and he went on to an easy three length decision in 1:55.2.

Peace of Art, another colt who's emerged as a stand out in recent weeks, captured the final division worth \$60,525. The Artsplace colt was tipped three-wide around horses by Milton's Steve Condren on the final turn to take the lead in early stretch.

He then gamely held off a late charging Day In A Life to win by a neck in 1:54.3.

Peace of Art has now won four of seven starts this year and banked \$168,520 for Laarman and partners Robert Grand and Ken McDaniel of Campbellville.

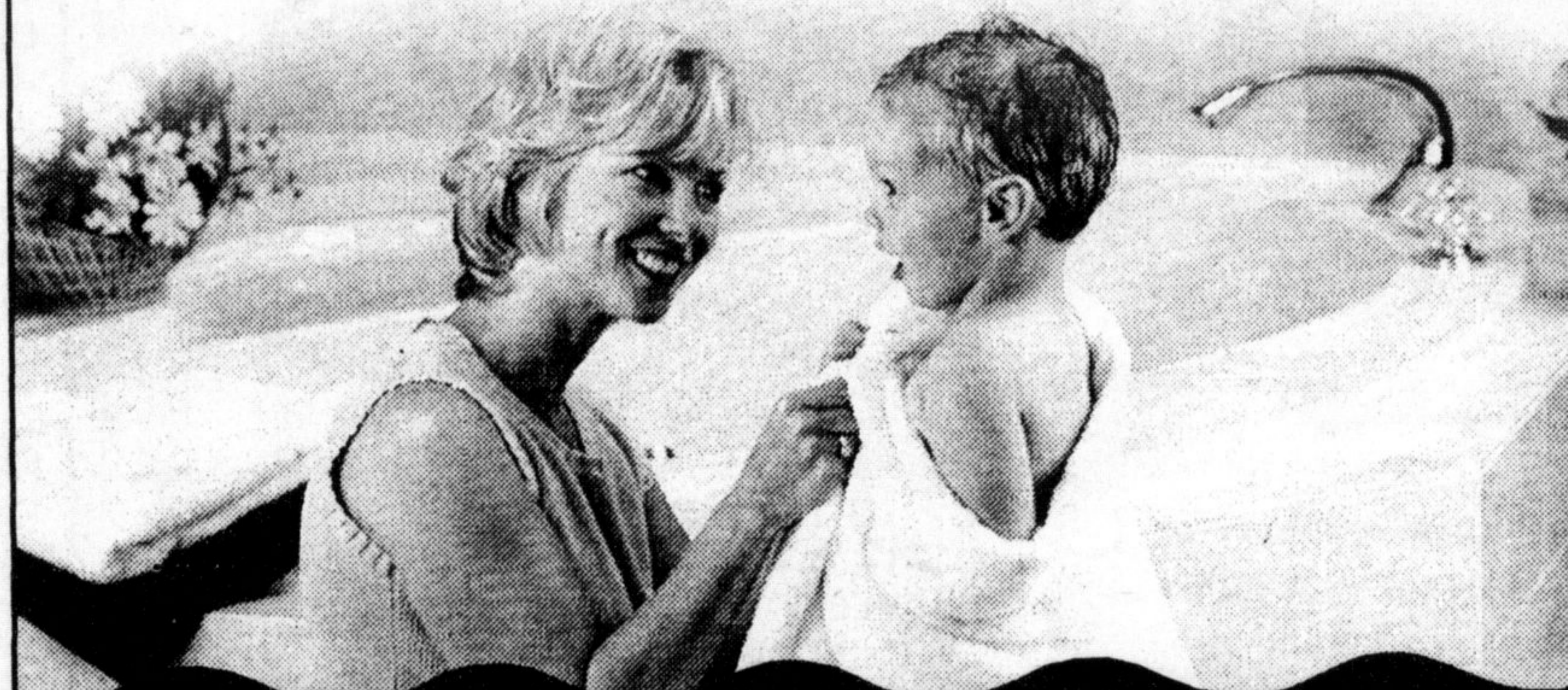

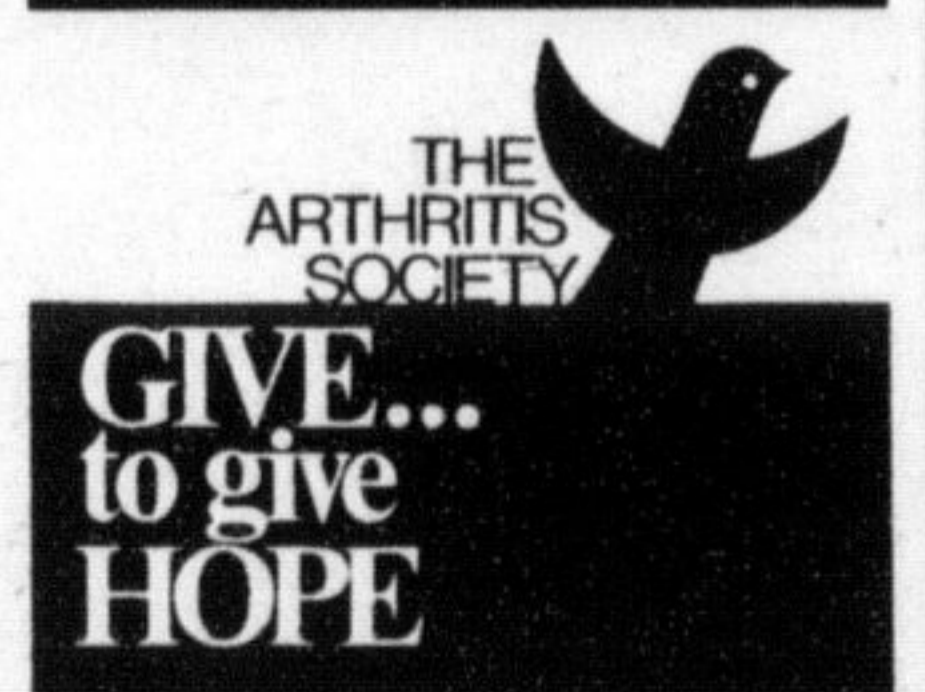
