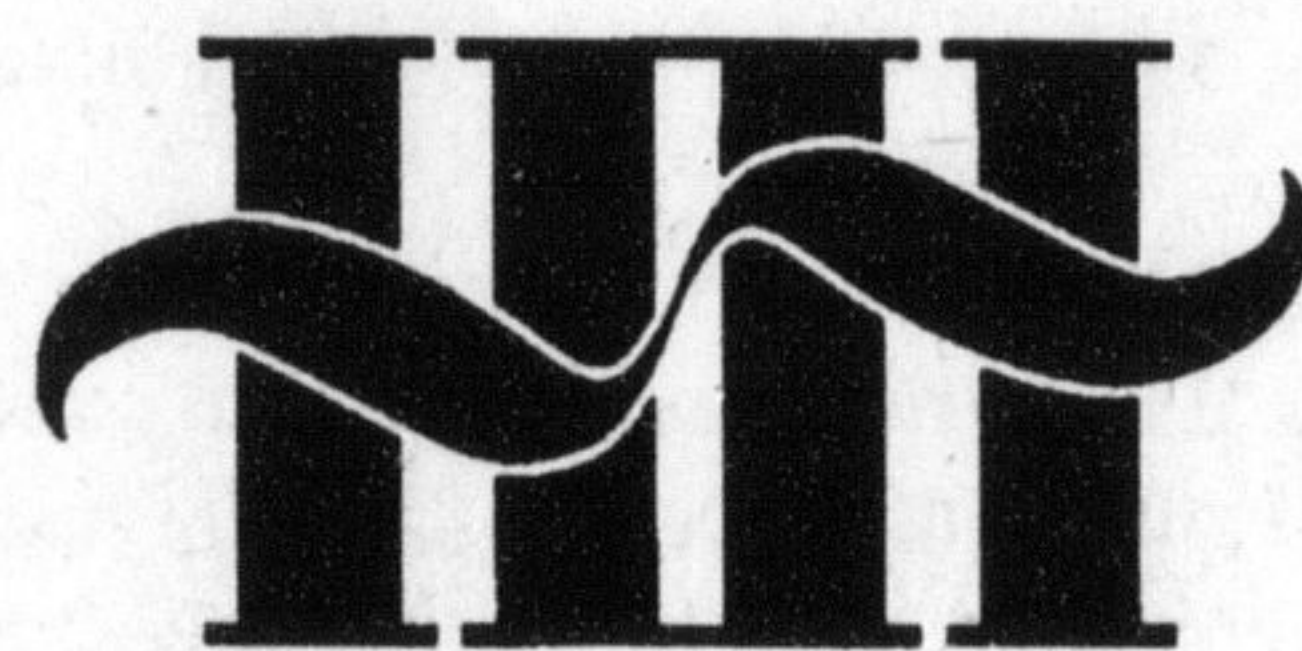
A pumpkin carving demonstration, crafts

PUBLIC MEETING 401 INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR

Council for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss proposed amendments to the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan and Zoning By-law for lands in the Steeles Avenue 401 Corridor to permit intensification of future industrial development on urban services under certain conditions.

The public is invited to attend the meeting to ask questions and provide comments. If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment, does not make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Zoning By-law or Official Plan

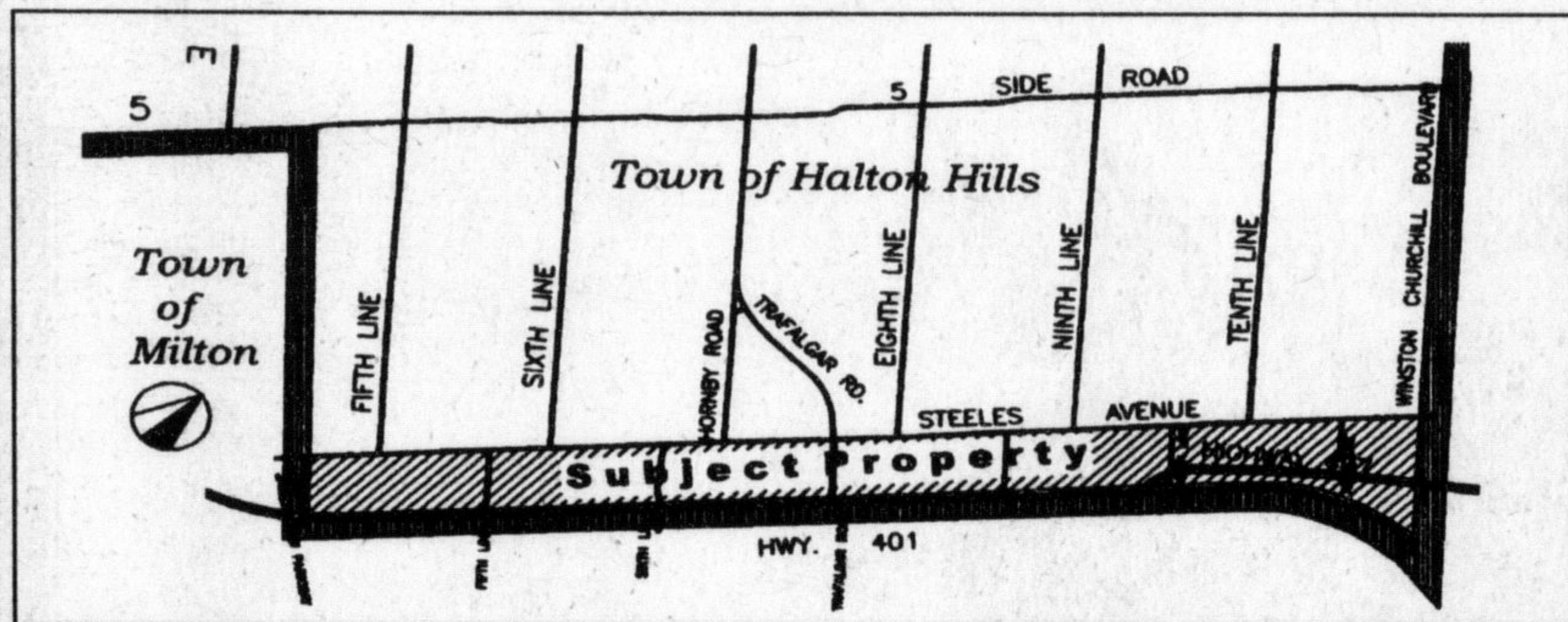
Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

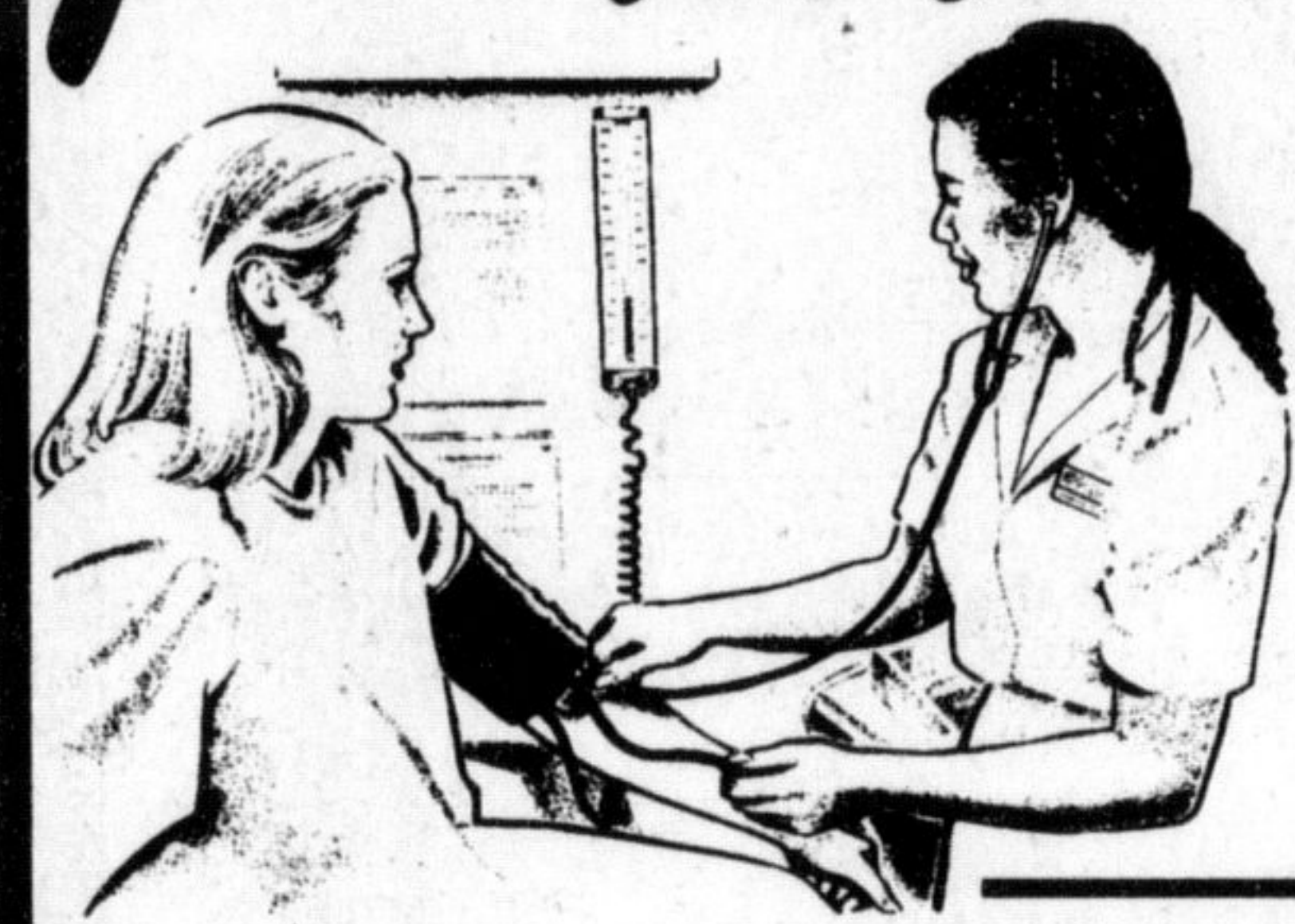
