Matt Reed led the way with a pair of goals while Strong, Tielemans, Nole Constranzous and Robbie Wilson contributed singles.

Robert Smith turned in superb goaltending.

He was equally effective in a previous outing with the Georgetown Raiders. Unfortunately, his teammates couldn't bury the biscuit enough and had to settle for a 1-1 draw. Strong and Webb set up Tielemans for the lone Milton tally.

Basketball tourney this weekend

Milton District High School will once again play host to the top female hoopsters in the province.

The second annual Mustangs Senior Girls Basketball Tournament will run Friday and Saturday, and feature eight powerhouse teams battling it out for bragging rights.

One of the heavy favourites has to be the returning Oakville Trafalgar Devils, which claimed bronze at last year's OFSAA finals and is now the top ranked team in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA).

The host 'Stangs stayed within seven points of OT in their season opener, which could make for an exciting rematch if they meet up in

the finals.

Back to defend their crown are the Markham Marauders, who have built a dynasty with top 10 GTA rankings over the past four seasons.

While they've lost franchise player Tammy Sutton-Brown to the NCAA, they still have two university-bound players in their line-up.

Standing in their way in first-round play is A.N. Myer. Niagara Region's premier team has a full roster returning this year.

Rounding out the card are Toronto's Michael Power (ranked third in GTA), Etobicoke (ranked ninth), Unionville (number 10

seed) and North Toronto, which enjoys top-notch coaching by Bill Doyle.

"This is going to be one heck of a tournament, perhaps even better than last year," said Mustangs coach Martha Gleeson.

The action gets underway at 3 p.m. Friday when Milton District battles Michael Power.

Other first-round matches include Markham vs. A.N. Myer, OT against North Toronto and Unionville vs. Etobicoke.

The consolation finals are scheduled for Saturday at 4 p.m. with the grand championship set to follow at 5:30 p.m.

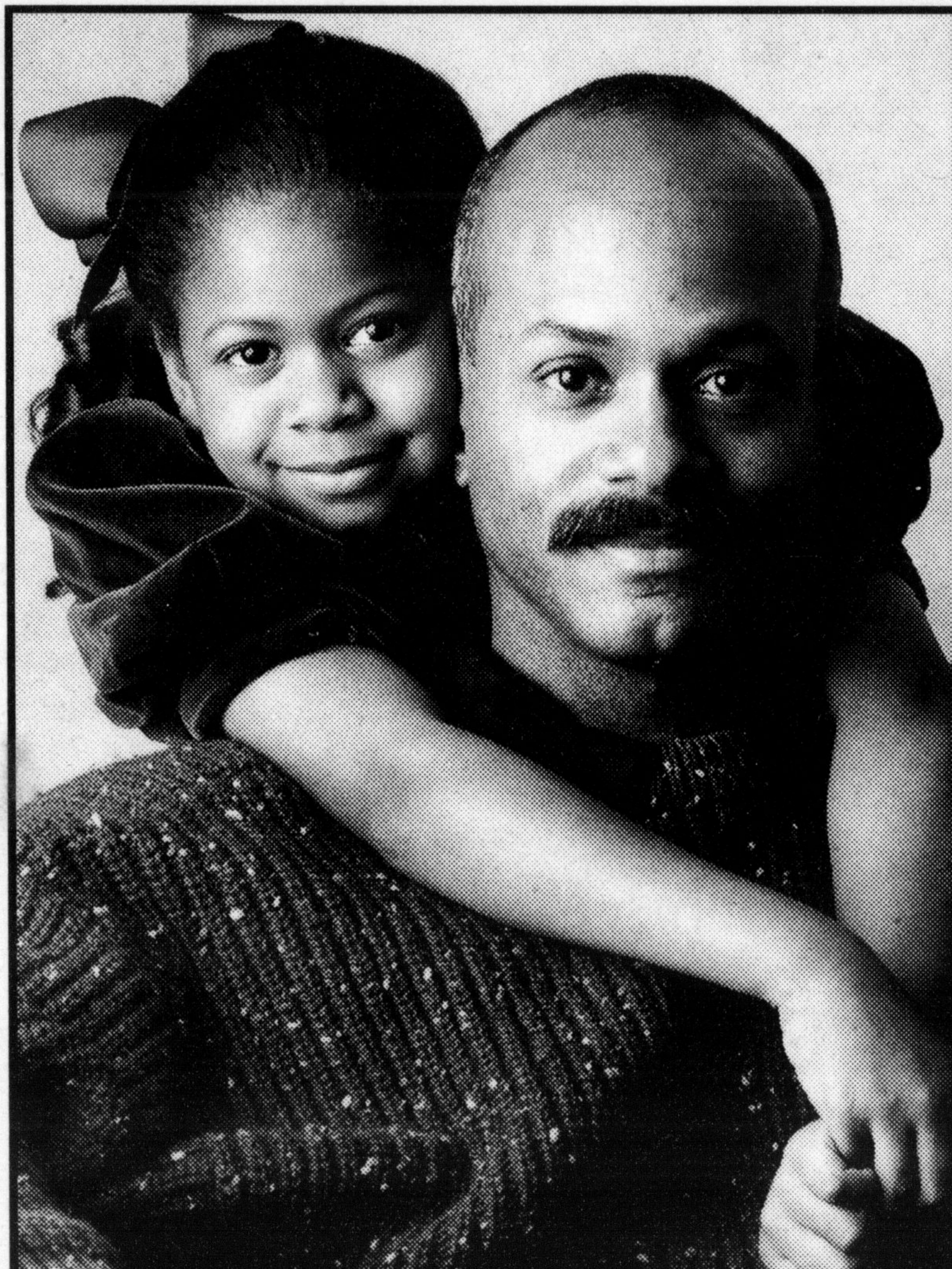
