

# No cold feet for thief

Someone in Milton is getting ready for winter and Crime Stoppers wants to know who.

During the Thursday night of October 2, the front door was forced open at the Racer's Edge at 32 Bronte St. S.

Once inside, the culprits searched the entire building, going through locked filing cabinets and desks before stealing four power generators and a substantial quantity of winter clothing.

The red-coloured generators were all made by Honda and were worth an estimated \$5,100.

The clothing included assorted sizes and styles of jackets and snow suits valued at almost \$15,000.

It is hoped someone saw something that might help solve the case or has heard of a person with similar items for sale. If so, Crime Stoppers wants to hear from you.

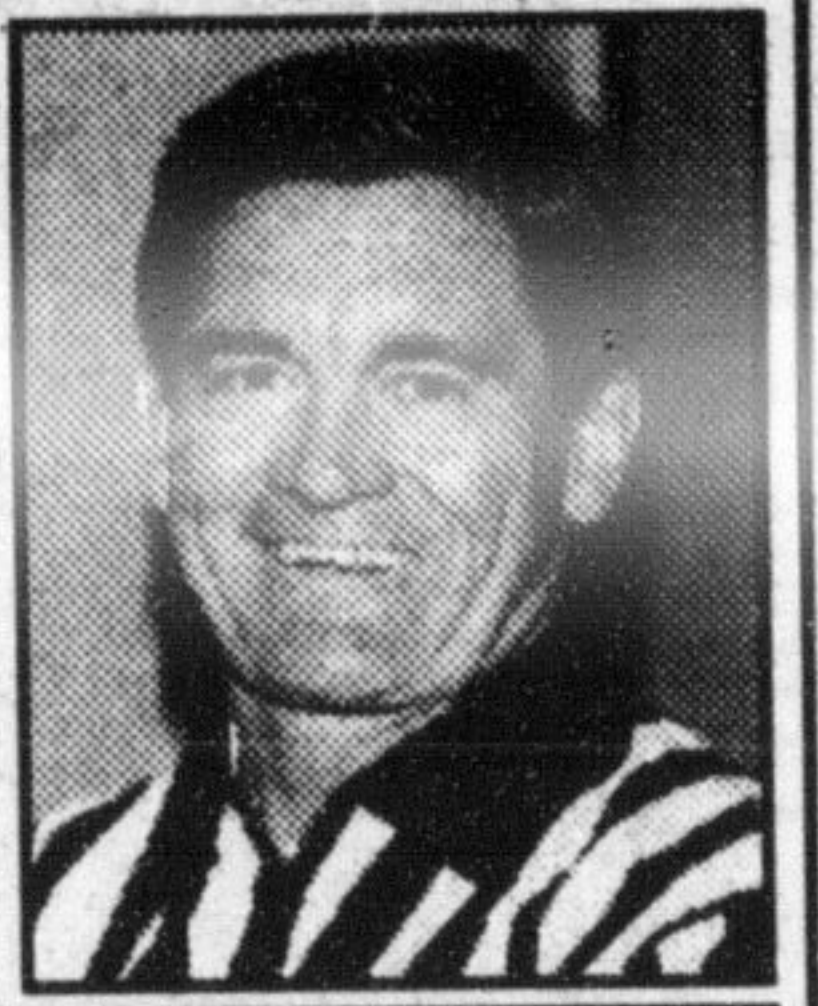
