# Crown land info on the Internet

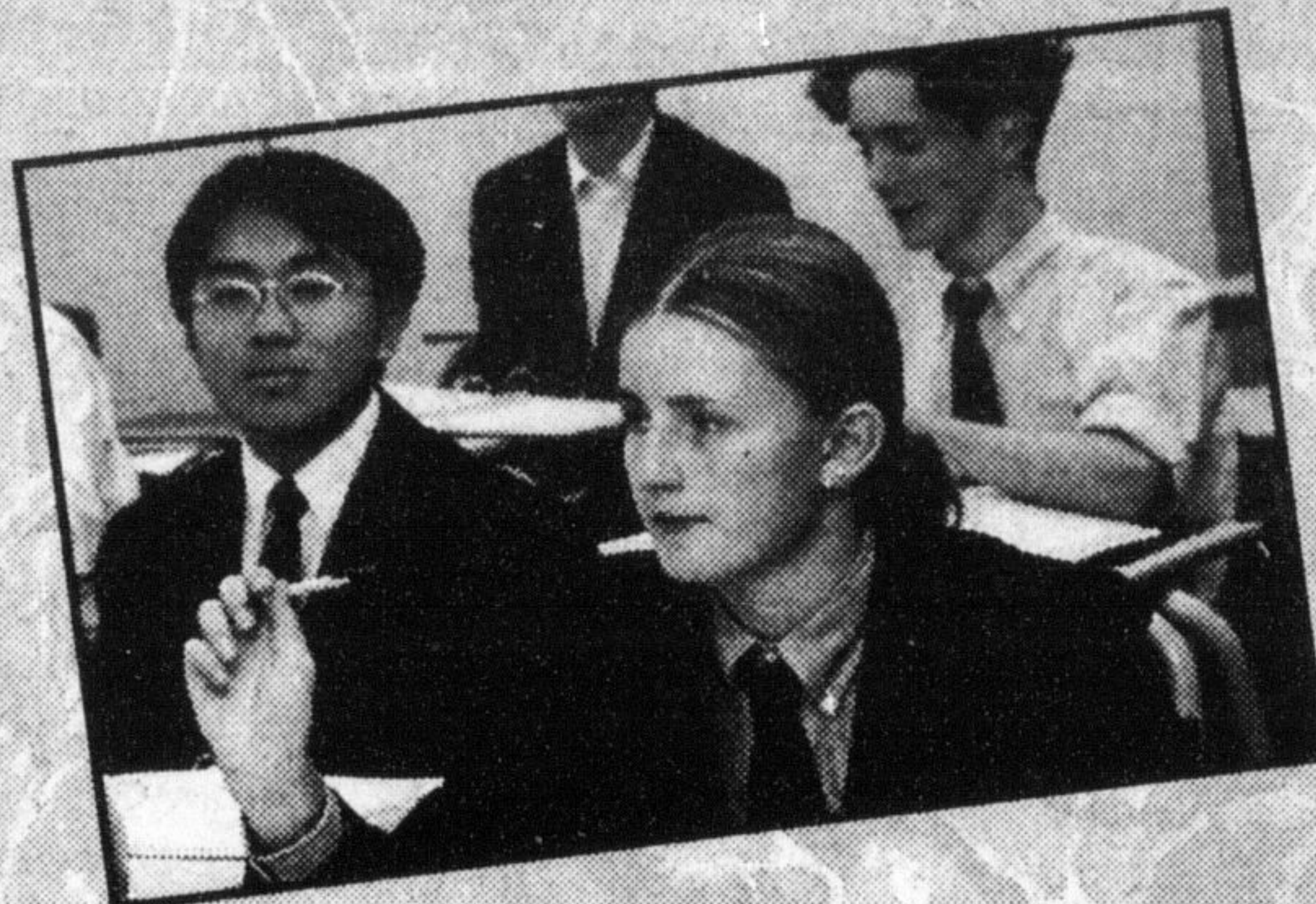
Lands for Life information is now available on the Internet, the Ministry of Natural Resources recently announced.

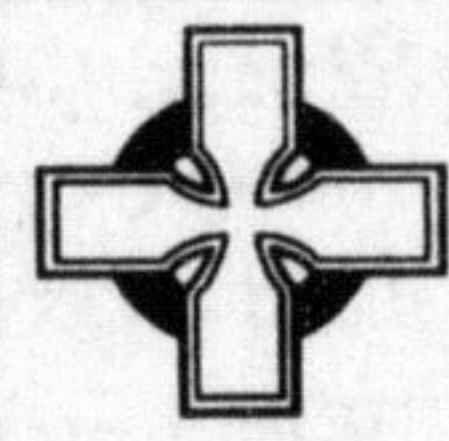

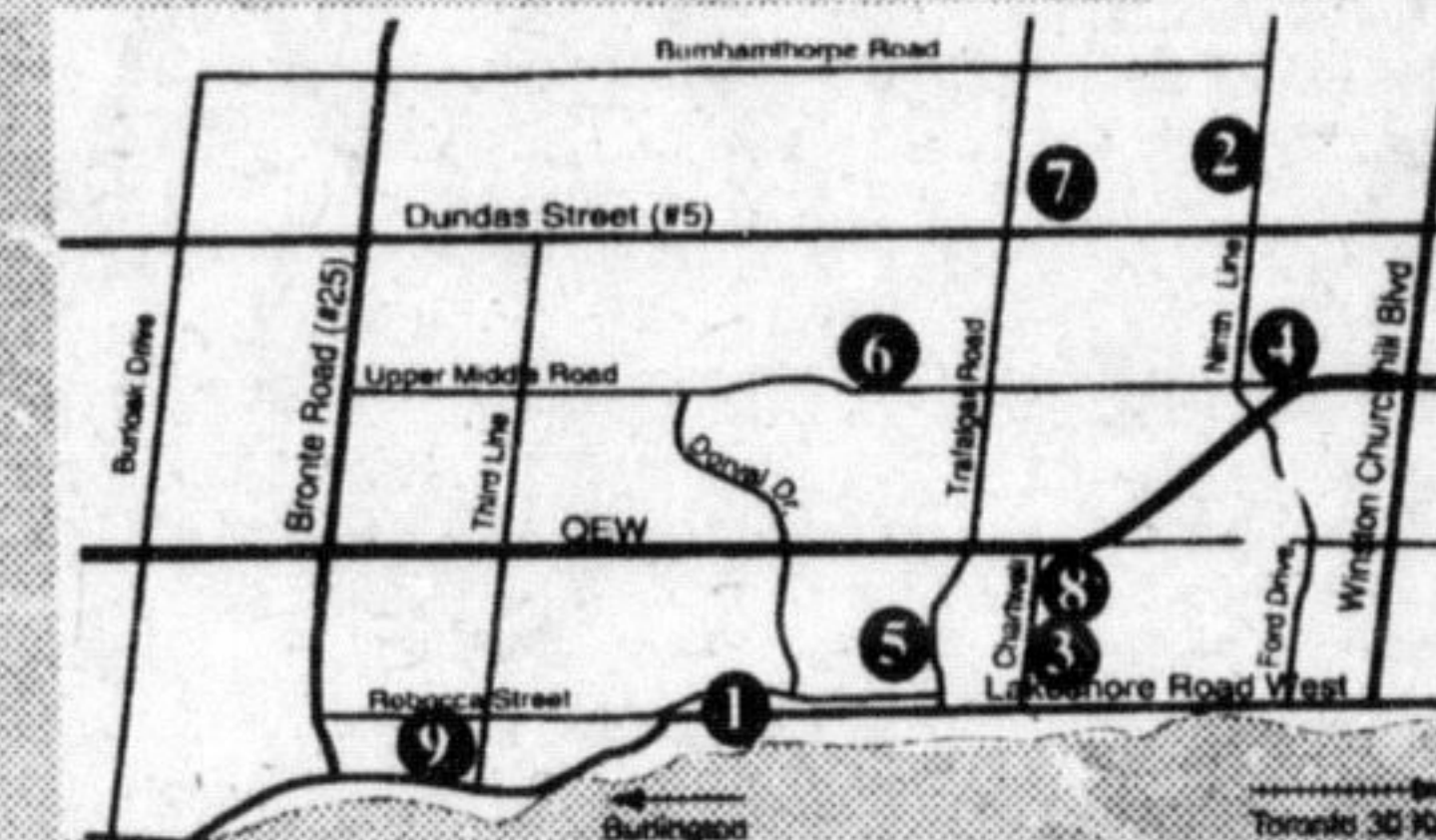
