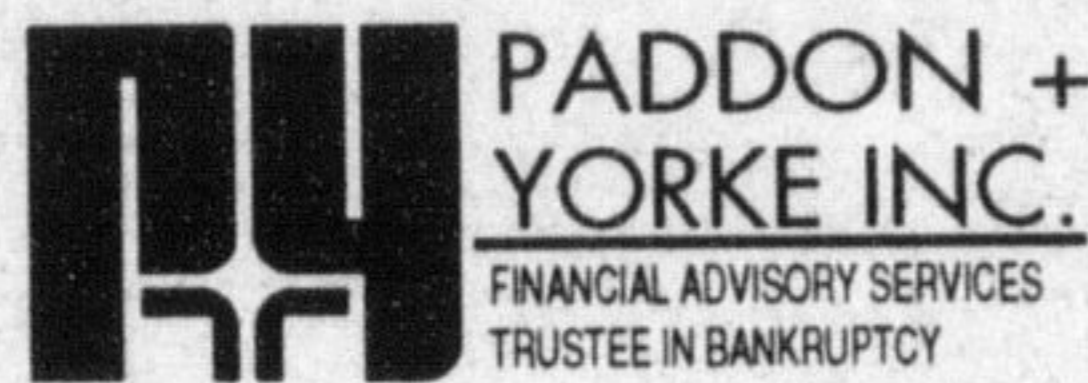

made-at-home plan presented recently at Halton regional council, the mayor said his and Milton council's decision should be reconsidered.

In addition the mayor says he is totally opposed to pooling social service funds across the Greater Toronto Area (GTA).

He said the province should solve Metro Toronto's property tax problems before attempting anything else.

"I've done much of the ground work on the big issues. I have the respect of my colleagues among GTA mayors," he said.

Mr. Krantz said he predicted the high property tax impact of provincial actions and warned that when services are amalgamated they tend to rise to the highest level.

"Our property tax base can't afford high end services," he said.
