**Wilson wants more responsibility**

Frank John Wilson wants to preserve the rural aspects of northern Milton.

The 30-year-old candidate to represent Ward 3 said the issue boils down to a threat from the province regarding a potential Greater Toronto Area (GTA) governing body, funding shifts and higher taxes.

"How is the GTA going to evolve?" he asked. "Fighting the GTA seems almost hopeless so we have to work to make the best adjustments possible."

Mr. Wilson said many people in the far north of the ward are suggesting an amalgamation with Wellington County or Waterloo Region.

Taxes are another issue, he said. Taxes are constantly increasing, mostly because politicians can always find a place to spend any extra money.

He called for a more open government, saying that people always hear of decisions after they are made, rather than being presented with the options.

Mr. Wilson suggested that a reserve firefighting force in Campbellville is not enough, especially when thousands of dollars are being spent on beautification projects.

"Is our safety being compromised for flower beds?" he asked.

The national-level motorcycle racer said he is used to the spotlight. He is also constantly involved in research and development of his equipment to try to improve performance. These are skills he would bring to government if elected, he said.

"We have to look at all the possibilities to get the best results," said Mr. Wilson.

Mr. Wilson also called for council to get down to the "nitty gritty" in their decisions and be more responsible.

Mr. Wilson's father, Frank Sr. is running for a council seat in urban Milton.

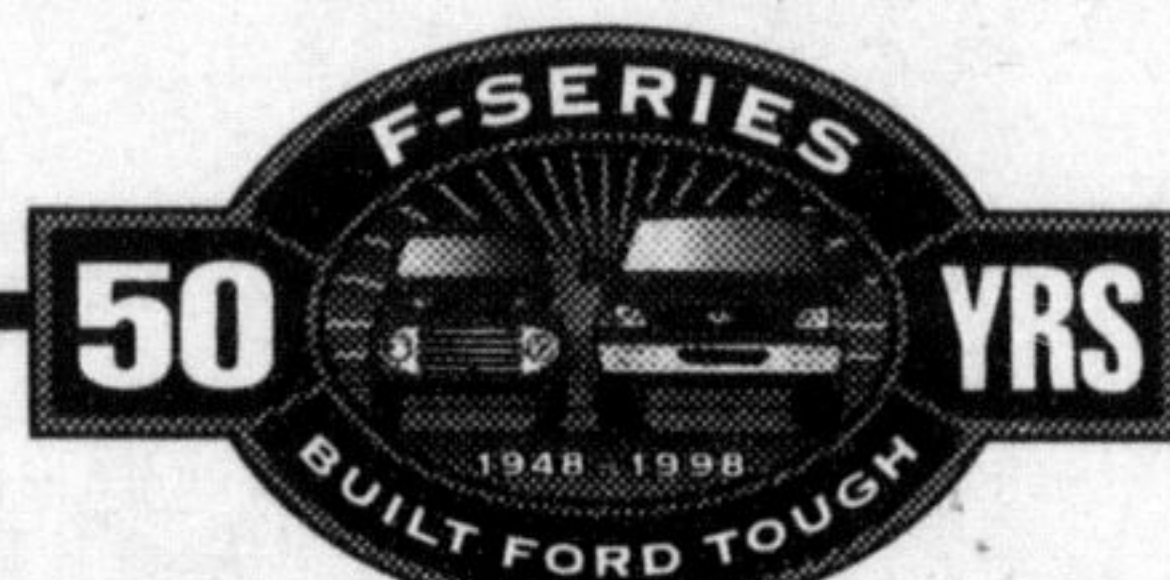

The person being appointed as the proxy must attend in person at the Clerk's Department with the proxy form to have it certified by an Election Official.
