We are busy evaluating the interim report of the Health Services Restructuring Commission and preparing our responses to it.

As you have read in the Champion, the Hospital is pleased that our Emergency, Inpatient and Outpatient Services will continue to be provided here in Milton. We will also work to ensure the directed amalgamation with the Oakville Hospital will be beneficial to both communities.

We do however have serious concerns with the number of inpatient beds the Commission feels will meet our community's needs. We are also carefully reviewing the funding dollars that they recommend will be needed to operate these beds in the future.

Look for regular updates here, in the Monitor, as we work our way through the opportunities and challenges that this interim report generates. We'll do our best to keep you informed.




