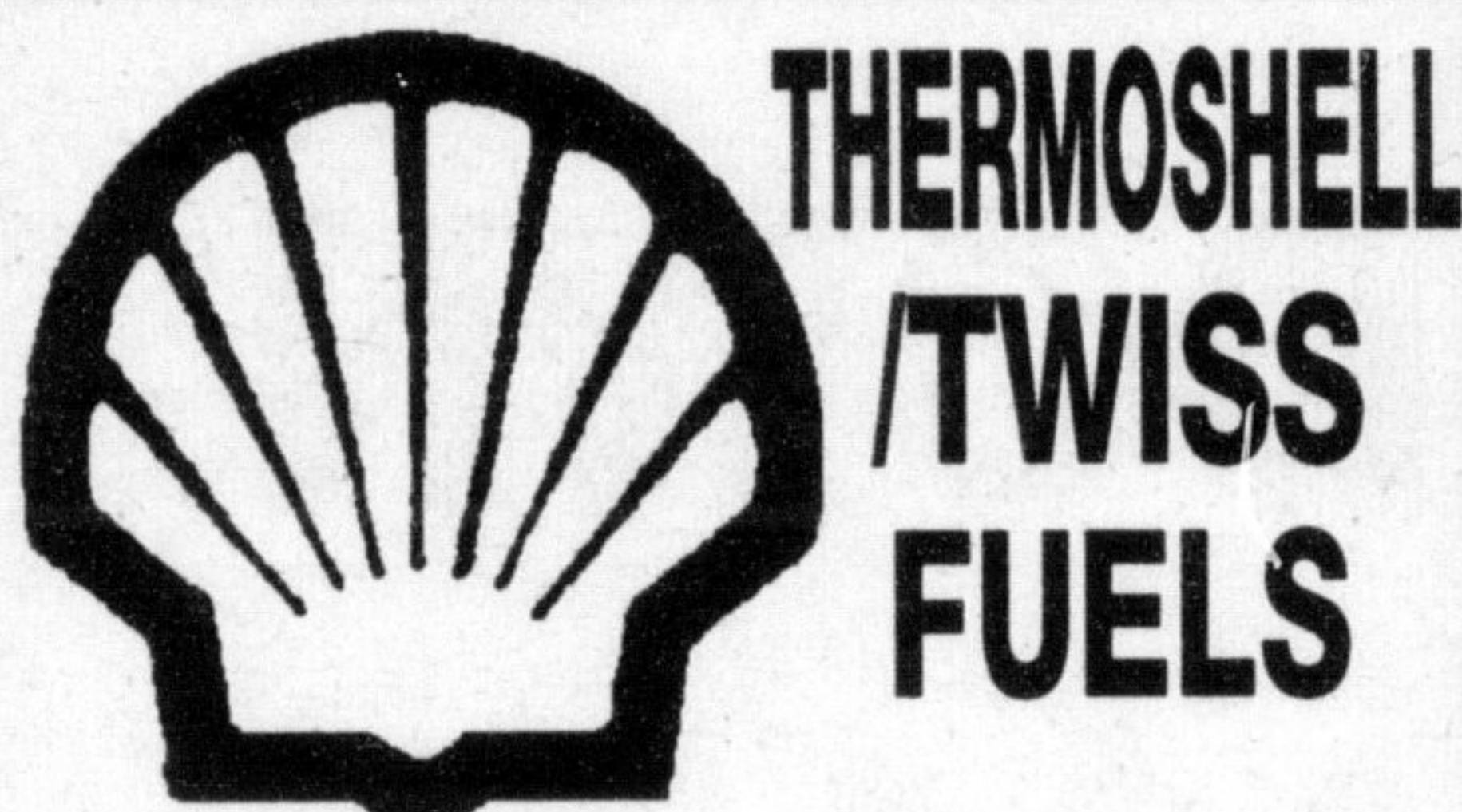

## Union donation

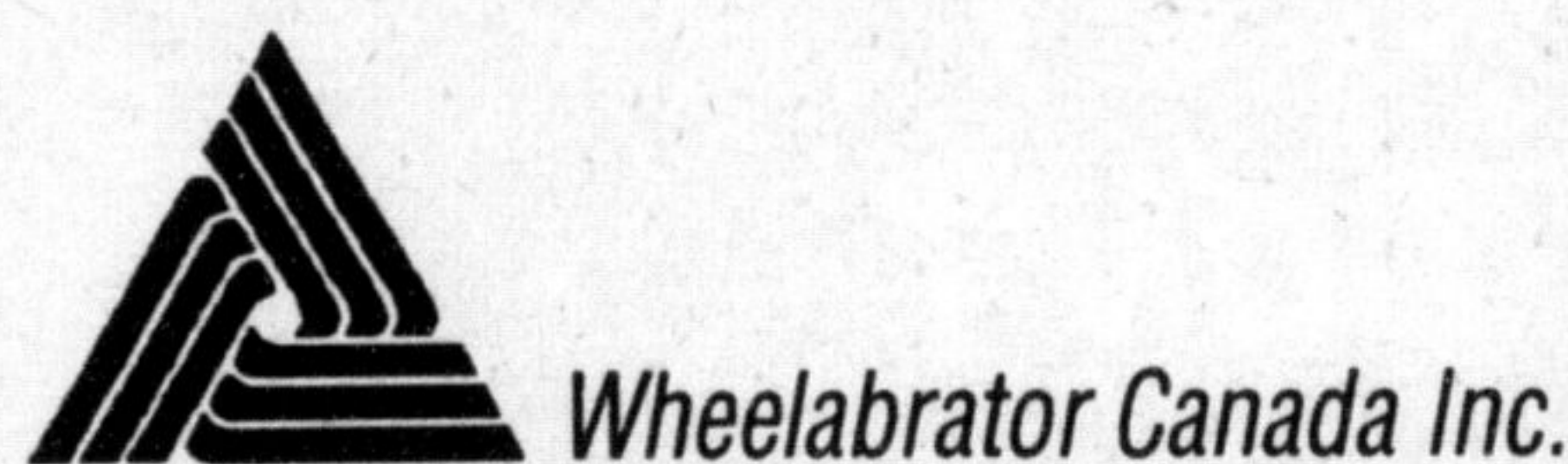
