

"There is a concern with citizens of Milton that we don't have the same police presence in town that we had prior to regional government," said Mr. Malboeuf. "People say the only time you see police in Milton is when they are going north or south to other places."

The councillor said with 900 new inmates at Maplehurst Correctional Facility and the presence of the regional courthouse in town, there are good reasons for more police in Milton.

Mr. Malboeuf said he would attempt to get answers for Milton residents but it will be more difficult from outside the loop. He hopes that his concerns about a lack of Milton representation on the board will be taken into consideration when the province makes its next set of appointments.

"The province should seriously look at Milton when it comes time. I hope they will see the discrepancy that's been created and will correct the situation," he said, adding that a lack of women on the board should also be reviewed.

Under cross-examination by defence lawyer Dirk Derstine at press time mid-Wednesday, Ms Gagnon said Mr. Madeley and Mr. Sheppard seemed to get along.

The first two days of testimony Monday and Tuesday featured reports from area residents, who told the court they saw Mr. Sheppard's five Pomeranian dogs wandering aimlessly around his home days before his body was found.

Fran Pearce of the Victorian Order of Nurses told the court she visited Mr. Sheppard March 7, 1995 to tend to his burned foot, but there was no sign of him at home.

## **Bribe alleged**


In the Crown's opening statements Monday, a jailhouse snitch appeared to be the key to its case.

Assistant Crown attorney Amy Stevenson told the nine-man, threewoman jury that the informant, who spent time with Mr. Madeley at Maplehurst Detention Centre in 1995, will testify the accused said he shot Mr. Sheppard three or four times with a sawed-off .22 calibre

The Crown will allege Mr. Madeley tried to bribe his jail mate, asking him to tell Halton Regional Police that he saw two men shooting at a shed on Mr. Sheppard's property.

The court placed a ban on publication of the informant's name.

The trial, which began January 19, was expected to continue yesterday and last four to six weeks.
