If you currently have diabetes or a cardiac condition - we have some exciting new programs you should be aware of:


• OUT PATIENT CARDIAC REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Currently, six participants are attending the twice per week exercise and education sessions. Our program aims to decrease the symptoms and reduce the risk of future cardiac problems, improve your knowledge and enhance your overall well being.


AUXILIAHBY
