Big change is made at the HRCA

The Murray Stephen era is over at the Halton Region Conservation Authority.

The HRCA general manager for the past 27 years agreed to step down following a meeting with the board of directors and on the heels of a consultant's report calling for changes in how the organization should operate.

Brian Penman, long-time HRCA chair, said the change in leadership came with mixed emotions for him personally.

"This person has lived the HRCA, been a dedicated employee and given a significant part of his life in defining and creating the success of the organization to date. There's nothing this process can do to sub-

tract from that history."

In 1997, the Randolph Group consulting firm was commissioned to conduct an organizational review. The final report was dealt with by the outgoing board of directors, but it hasn't yet been presented to the new board.

Mr. Penman said, "The restructuring allowed us to consider the definition of the organization and how this organization would be best represented to do business in the 21st century." The organization should be seen as more user friendly toward applications from the watershed, he said. Also, a less adversarial approach is needed toward funding partners, including municipalities and the
