Veterans up in arms over the War Museum expansion controversy

Dear Editor:
The Museum of Civilization capitulated on the main issue in an announcement February 18, 1998 that the Holocaust Gallery

would not be included in the expansion plans for the War Museum.
There still remains some unanswered questions which veterans placed before the Senate Subcommittee.
The War Museum should have its own board separate from the Museum of Civilization
The government should honour the financial commitment made by the Museum of Civilization (\$7 million).
The Advisory Committee, headed by the Honourable Barnett Danson, should be able to operate independent of the Board of Trustees of the Museum of Civilization.
This will be difficult under the present circumstances, as Mr. Danson is only one of 11 members of the main museum board.
Moreover, the advisory committee still includes the main players who caused the controversy.
