DARE help lauded Club wants

Six of the DARE Halton program's benefactors were honoured recently for their support.

At a ceremony before the Halton Regional Police Services Board, DARE chair Johanne Slomka handed out plaques to those who help keep the initiative afloat.

The 17-week DARE (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) program is offered to all grade 6 students in Halton by specially trained officers and is funded by police, both school boards and the province.

The latter portion has been declining annually so the volunteer DARE Halton board is required to raise \$250,000 each year. Support has been received from service clubs, the educational community and concerned companies.

Based in Toronto, First Brands Canada chose to throw its "enthusiastic support" behind the Halton DARE program, said Ms Slomka.

Regional Chair Joyce Savoline accepted a plaque on behalf of Halton Region, which turned over the proceeds of last year's golf tournament.

Burlington Councillor John Taylor urged a go-slow approach.

He suggested other areas such as sharing expertise between municipalities be considered.

As the committee entered its second year a new chair was elected to replace Mr. MacIsaac. Halton Chair Joyce Savoline won the position unopposed, however Mr. MacIsaac suggested staff assistants come from other segments of Halton to counter any perception that the HASR process is driven by the senior level of municipal government.

While the committee agreed to have staff consider the situation and report back with options Mr. Krantz was unconcerned.

"I deal more with reality and not perception," he said, adding that staff support from Milton is not available. "I could care less what people perceive."

The committee agreed to establish the two-year goal for final decisions from the HASR process.
