#### MDH FINALIZES BALANCED **BUDGET FOR 1998/99**

Our Hospital's Board of Directors approved a balanced budget for 1998/99 which maintains all services at their current level.

On an annual basis, it costs \$15,790.815. to operate our Hospital's programs and services. Up to 80% of this funding comes from the Provincial Ministry of Health.

#### Maintaining MDH's state of the art facilities and equipment - a \$1.2 million challenge!

This coming year, MDH is planning to invest \$1.2 million in new medical and hospital equipment. Major purchases will modernize our Intensive Care Unit, our Diagnostic Imaging Department as well as our Operating Rooms and Laboratory.

You should know the Government does not provide grants to purchase this needed equipment. A major source of funds to make these purchases comes directly from community support to our Foundation and our Auxiliary. Your donations, together with the Hospital's own capital reserves, are our only source of income for these capital purchases.

Thank you to everyone in our community for helping ensure that MDH remains a modern, well equipped Hospital providing high quality care and service.
