The Milton Branch of the Canadian Cancer Society, is responsible for a large portion of what is now the North Halton Unit of the Canadian Cancer Society, encompassing all territory, south of 15 sideroad to lowerbase line east to the ninth line and west to the Milton WentWorth town line. The focus of the Canadian Cancer Society is to provide funds for patient services, scientific research, and education especially in the field of disease prevention and health promotion. It is totally supported by public donations, receiving no government aid. It is not part of the United Way.

Locally, over four hundred volunteers participate in the April fundraising campaign, made up of the residential Canvassers, Daffodil Days and Denim Days Volunteers.

Throughout the year, through the generosity of many individuals in Milton and the surrounding areas, funds are raised by memorial gifts, sporting events and social gatherings such as

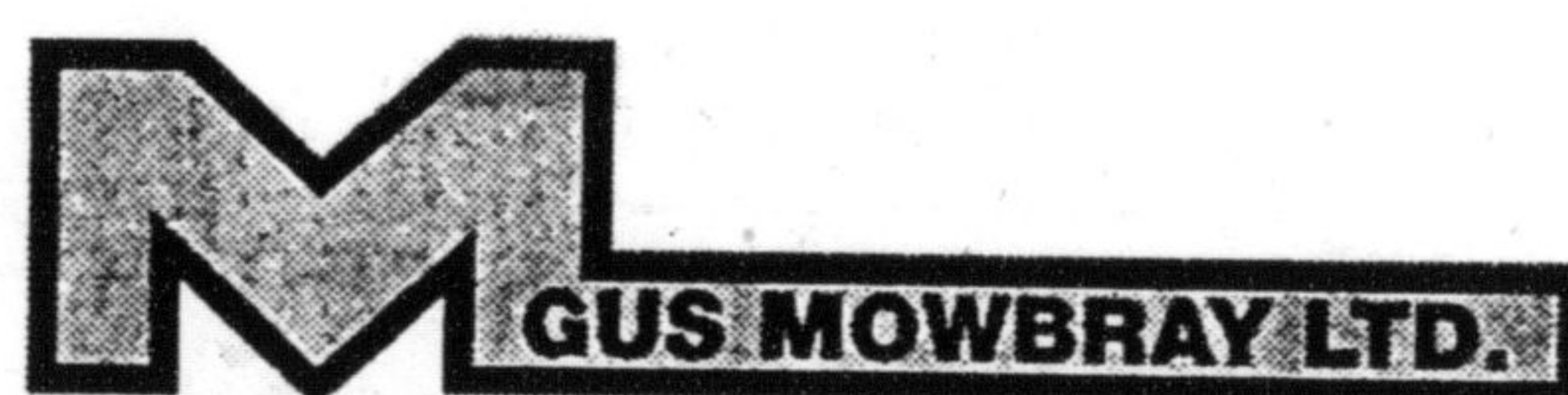

Almost daily, at least two trips are made taking patients and sometimes their family members to the various treatment centres in the Greater Toronto Area and Hamilton regions.
