on the second floor or simply paying your taxes in the Treasury department. That's where we will be located, the former treasury office.

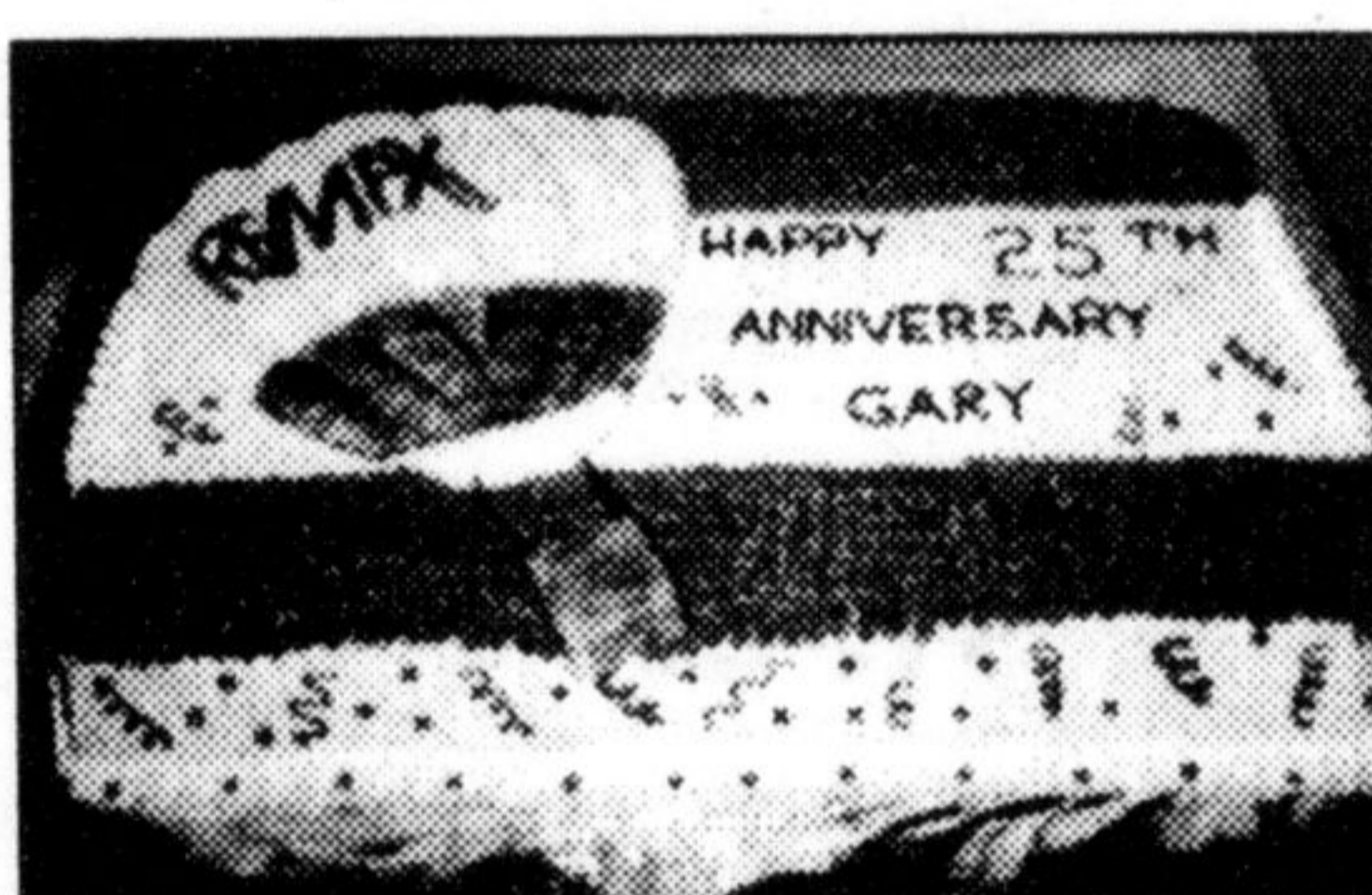

was responsible for putting together the deal to make the station the home

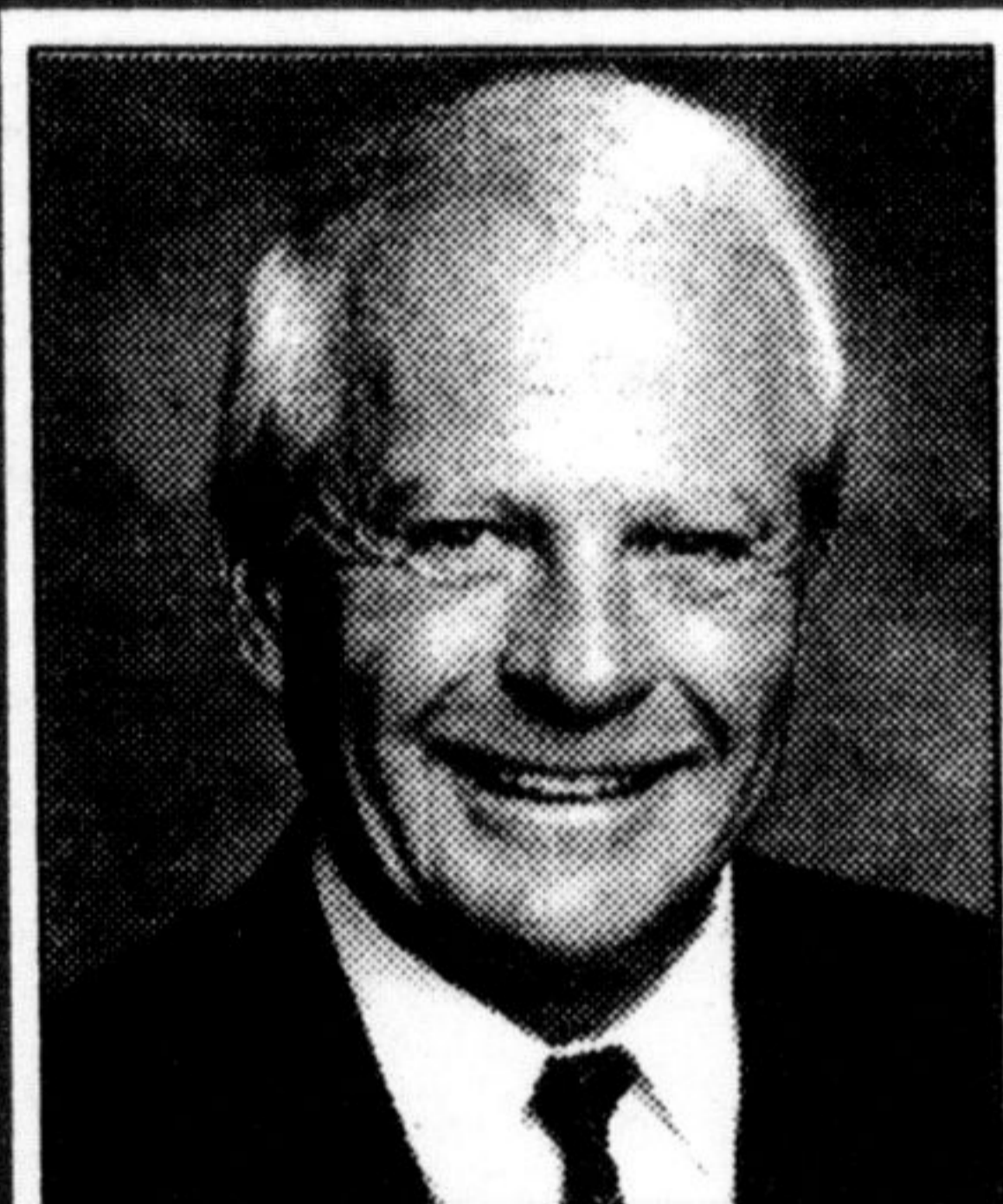
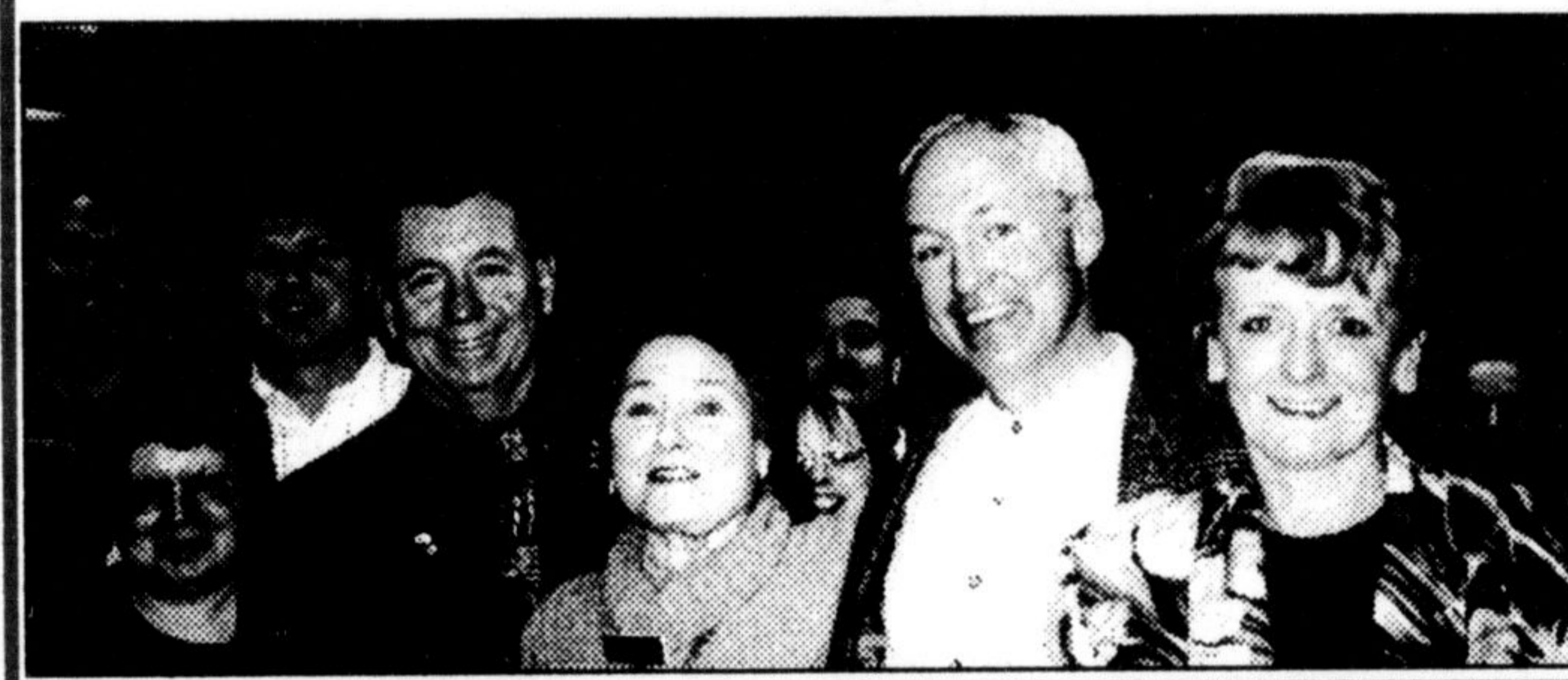

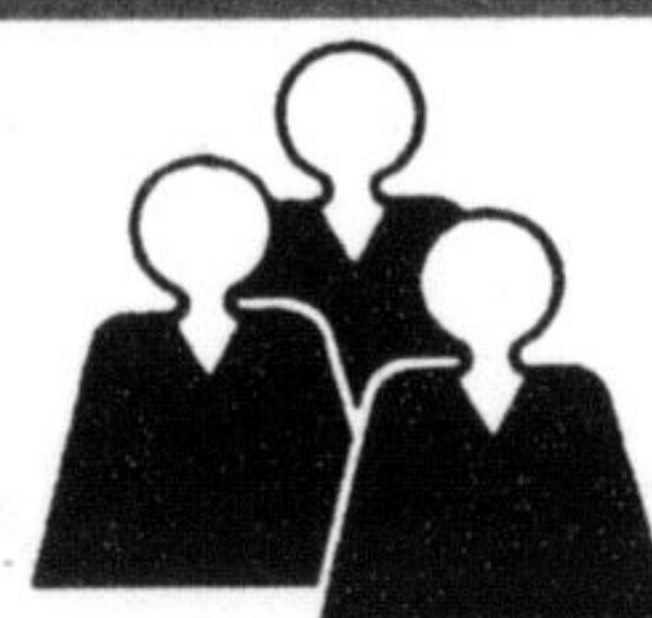
