Dear Editor:

I would like to clarify a few points on the coyote article written by Irene Gentle in the March 31 issue.

The survey that my wife and I distributed had two purposes. It was designed to alert our neighbours that our encounter with the two attacking coyotes and a third larger one indicated a more aggressive animal than I would have expected.

The second purpose of the survey was to determine if this was an isolated incident. The survey indicated that it was not. A subsequent sighting in our backyard revealed that one of the three was the size of a large German Shepherd.

Our greatest concern was for avoiding an incident involving young children. Larger sized animals, lacking fear of humans and obviously hungry, could lead to an unfortunate incident.
