

Bertoli, Tigers take eastern title

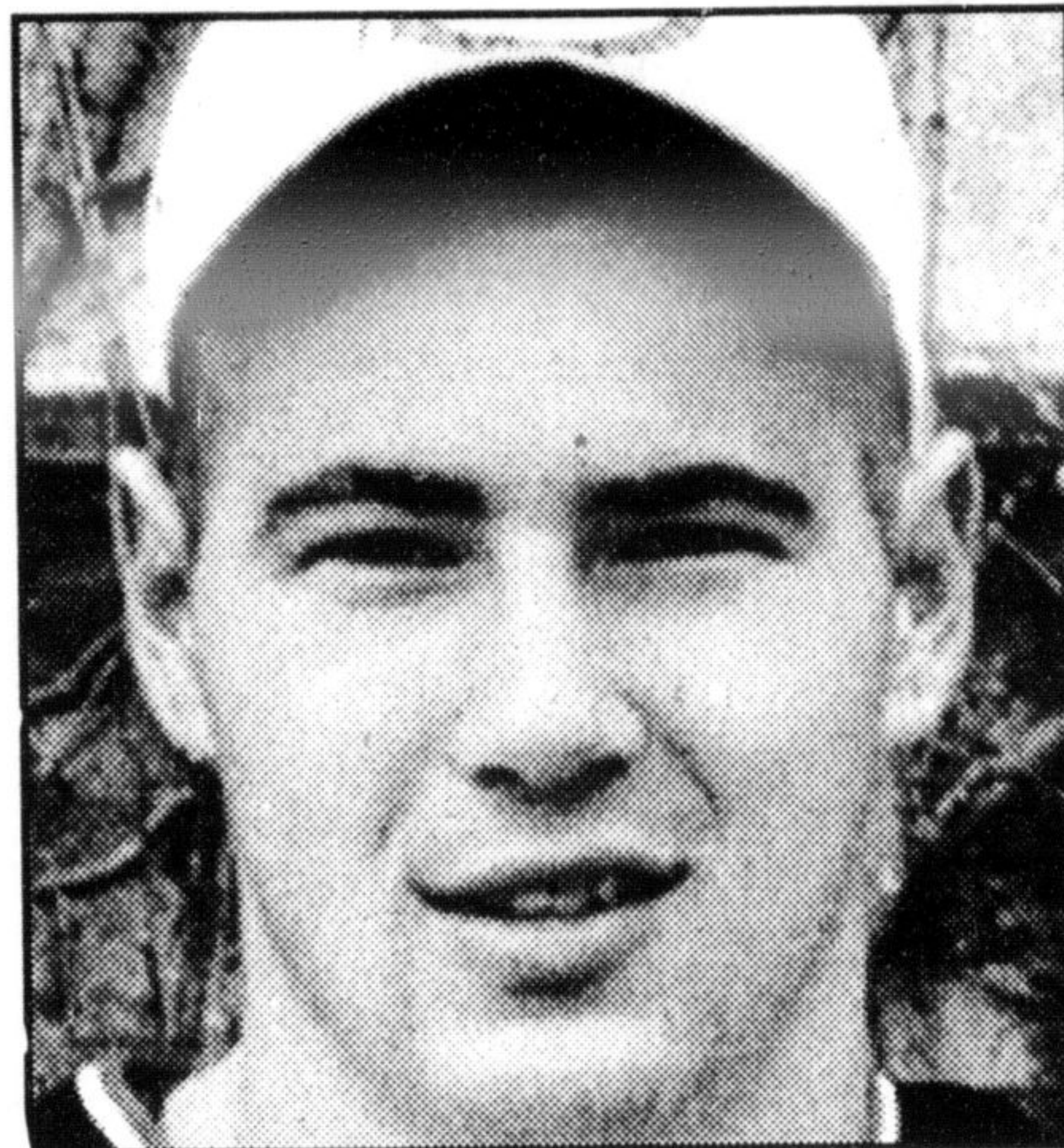

Scott Bertoli and the Princeton Tigers took the high endurance test recently in capturing their first-ever Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference (ECAC) title.

Just four days after beating Brown in a best-of-three opening round series, the Tigers completed their championship run with three wins in as many nights.

They clinched the title with a pulse-pounding 5-4 double overtime victory against highly favoured Clarkson.

"It was definitely the highlight of my hockey career," said Bertoli, recalling the celebration that followed Syl Apps' game winner.

"We were picked as underdogs through-

out the ECAC playoffs but we knew we could win it. We had scored some big wins over Clarkson and Boston University early in the year and it was only when we started getting hit with the injury bug midway through the season that we really struggled."

A left winger on Princeton's highly accomplished 'orange line', Bertoli drew an assist in the Clarkson game and another during their 2-1 squeaker over Yale.

Their other ECAC win came in a 6-2 drubbing to Cornell.

History and fortune were against Bertoli and the Tigers in their first National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) tournament appearance in Lake Placid.

They dropped a 2-1 first-round decision to Michigan, who went on to win a record ninth national championship Saturday over Boston College.

Michigan's game winner against Princeton was as fluky as they come. Mark Kosick was credited with the goal that ricocheted off Jeff Halpern's skates to dribble between goalie Erasmo Salterelli's feet early in the third.

Recalled Bertoli, "It was the weirdest goal I've ever seen. He (Kosick) was passing to someone behind the net and had absolutely no intention of scoring.

"It's hard to say if they (Michigan) would have won anyway. They really took it to us in the first period but had five power-play chances and couldn't score on any."

Bertoli has one more season remaining with the Ivy League school.
