

Teen faces weapons charges

A 16-year-old Milton youth faces assault and weapons charges in connection with a scuffle at Main and Martin streets Saturday.

The altercation involved a knife, and a youth suffered a cut to his hand, said Det. Sgt. Jackie Gordon of Halton Regional Police.

The incident remains under investigation.

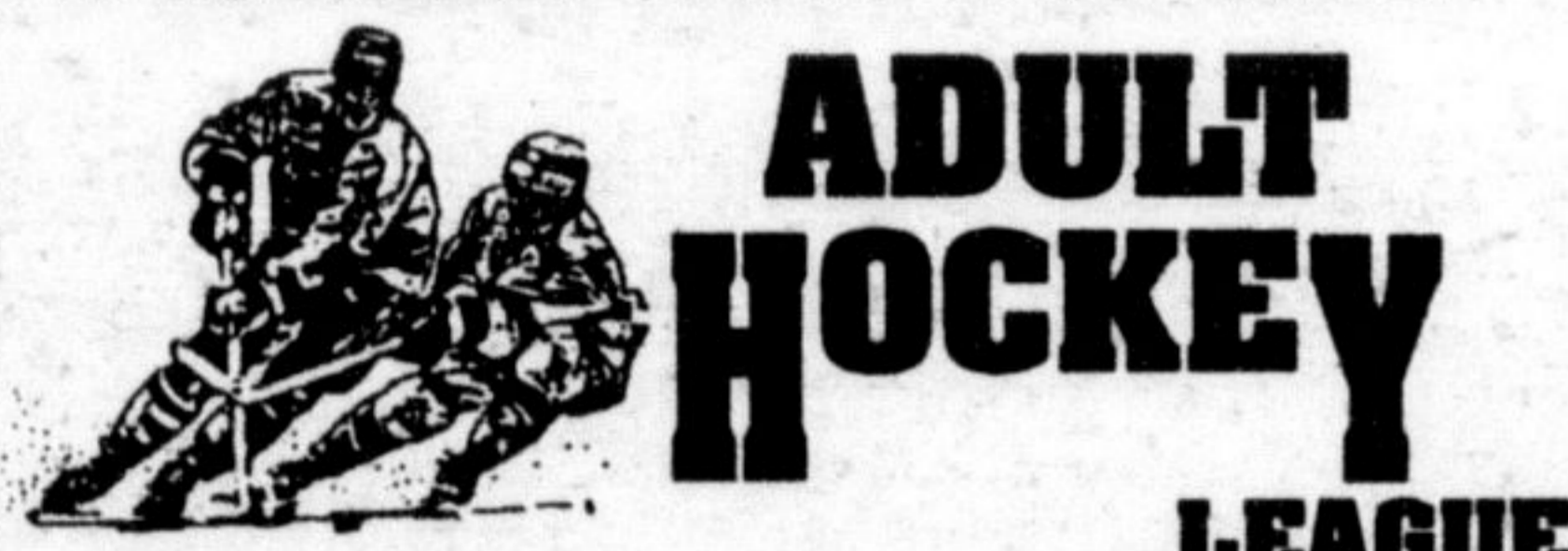

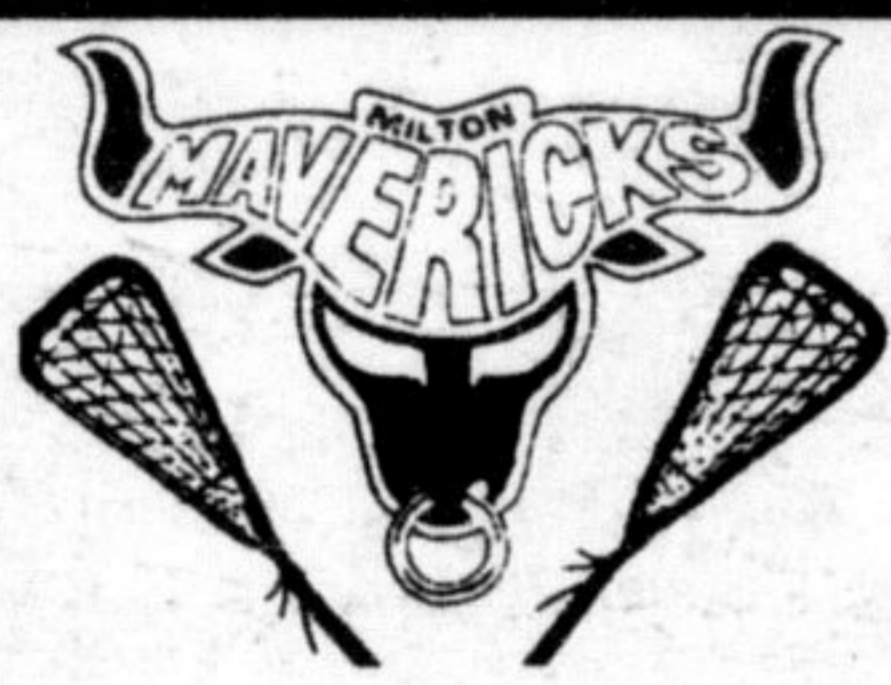
