



The REGION OF HALTON and the FARE SHARE FOOD BANK ask that residents donate a **NON PERISHABLE** food item (especially spaghetti sauce, canned fruit and cereal) when dropping off tires.


- Halton Region residents may drop off up to 8 residential passenger vehicle tires (rims included)
- Bicycle, wheelbarrow and lawn mower tires will also be accepted
- Commercial vehicle, truck and tractor tires will NOT be accepted
- Tires are not collected as part of the Region's regular or bulk waste collection programs
