assessor.

"It's simple. For reasons of security we've always insisted on independent criteria for assessments," said Mr. Rinaldo.

"We're saying we don't want to be making judgment calls on an institution. We can't evaluate the level of risk."

Mr. Rinaldo said the Region's refusal to deal with un-rated credit unions shouldn't be taken as a credibility statement.

"If I were dealing with my own money I wouldn't hesitate to put it in a credit union. In the past I have," said Mr. Rinaldo.

"But the bottom line for me is we're dealing with taxpayers' money."

He said the committee would be unlikely in the short term to change a policy that has over the years has helped Halton achieve its present triple A rating.

"In the 1980's when some municipalities were in trouble, when some financial institutes were in trouble, we weren't," pointed out Mr. Rinaldo. "That's where the policy has served us in the past."
