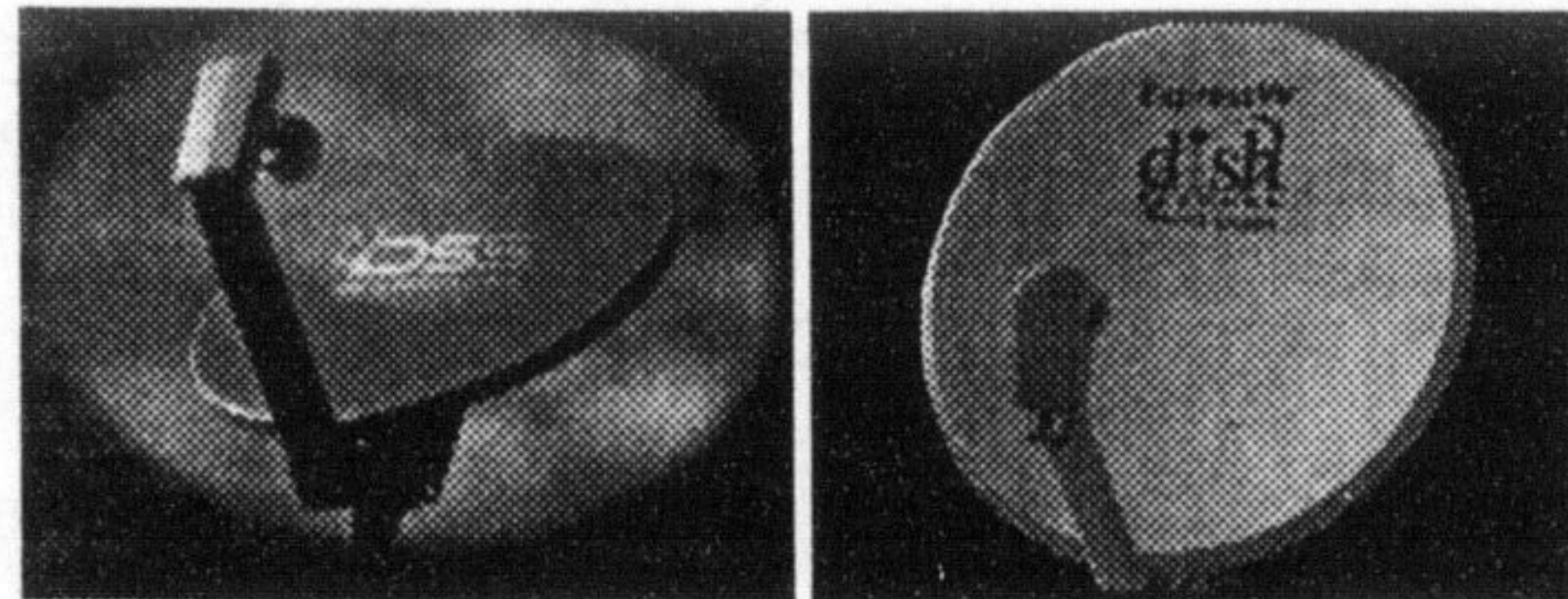

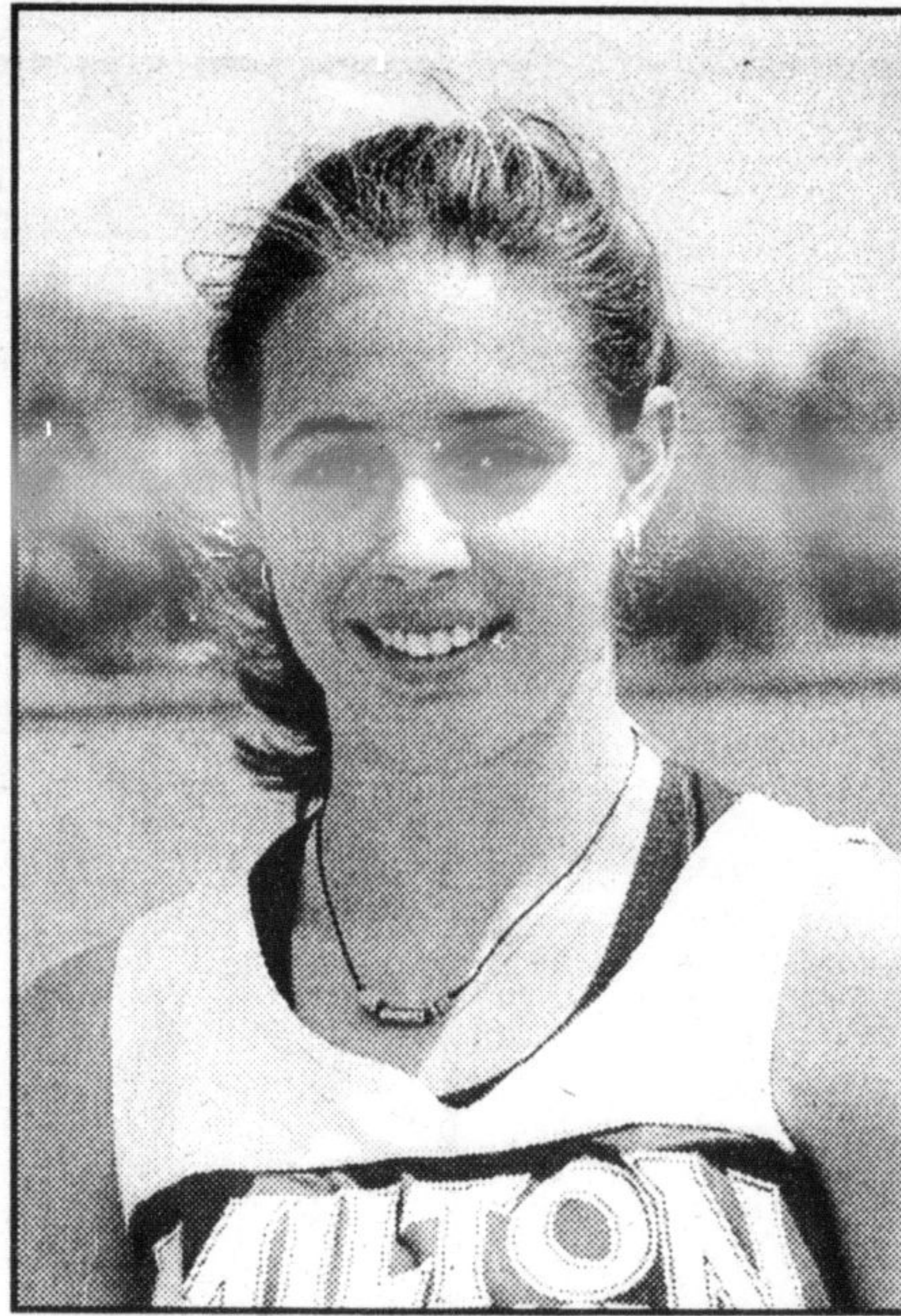

Up until the last 20 metres of the finals she was neck and neck with the bronze medalist, who ended up beating her by just half-a-second.

"I really thought Brooke had both the third and fourth place finishers," remarked Anderson.

Recurring ailments struck at the worst possible time for two local athletes.

The latest attack of right side pain and discomfort single-handedly destroyed Carrie Meltzer's hopes in the junior girls 3,000m.

The 16-year-old MD runner showed strongly through lap one and two but started leaning to her left on the third go-around and was pretty much out of the thick of things from then on.

Determined to finish the race, she staggered home in 20th spot.

Drury sprinter Ashlee Wocker, 15, re-injured her knee early last week and couldn't compete at all, although she made the trip north. Just minutes into Thursday's practice however, it was clear her season was over. Bishop Reding senior Shawnda Marques was well off her personal best in the long jump. She took 21st spot.

Brookville blows them away

Explosive speed and high endurance. Brookville School's intermediate girls had ample amounts of each Thursday at the Halton Tier 2 Track and Field Championships in Burlington.

As a result they blew away the competition — winning seven of 10 events and outscoring runner-up Eastview by 66 points — and helped the Bengals place second in the overall standings.

Ashley Lane covered the short distance end of things with victories in the 100 and 200m dashes, clocking in at 14:04 and 30:31 seconds respectively.

Another two-time winner, Erin Greenfield ran the 400m in 1:15.04 and the grueling 1,500m in 6:50.05 to beat all challengers in each event.

Helping Brookville make a clean sweep on the track was Janine Nash, who prevailed in the 800m with a 3:05.65 finish. She also took second in the triple jump with a 8:40m leap — just a nose behind fellow Bengal Blair Davey.

Krista Kearns hurled the shot-put 10:56m for a convincing win. Her closest competition came from teammate Jacelyn Merritt who turned in a 9:27m effort.

Ashley Codner was third in the high jump, clearing 1.25m, while Lane, Greenfield, Nash and Davey ran the 4x100m relay to second-place honours.

Brookville's junior girls made the second biggest contribution towards the team silver medal with a second-place showing of their own.

Leading the way was multi-talented Dawn Brunschwiler whose medal haul included a gold in the triple jump — with a leap of eight metres even — plus silver in both the long jump (3:42m) and 400m (1:19.68).

Nicole Cowper broke the seven-minute mark in the 1,500m for top spot while Joanne Schenker took first in the shot-put with a throw of 9:16m.

Aryka Noble was second in both the shot-put and high jump.

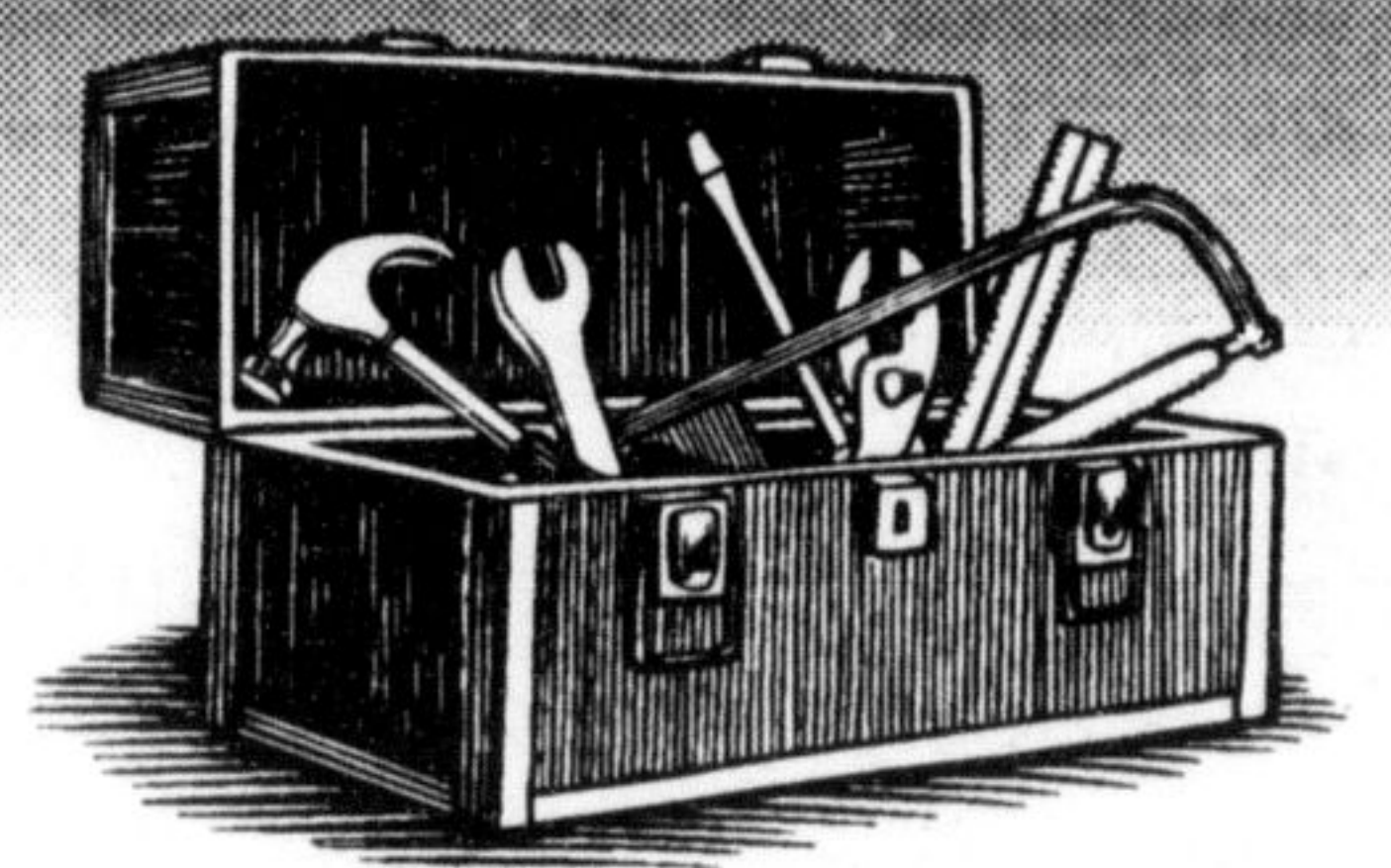
