# Loblaws is fined over building too soon

Loblaws has been fined \$15,000 for starting construction of its new Nipissing Road grocery store without a building permit and failing to comply with a stop work order issued by the Town of Milton. The grocery store chain pleaded guilty to the charges

in Ontario Court (provincial division) in Milton June 4.

Court heard Loblaws began construction of its new \$4 million store behind Milton Mall in April before the building permit it had applied for in February was approved.

### Stop work order

As a result, the Town of Milton ordered the company to stop the work April 14, shortly after it inspected the site. However, Loblaws continued construction so charges were laid April 28.

A judge ordered Loblaws to pay \$7,500 for each

violation.

The company obtained the permit it applied for shortly after it was charged, said John DeVries, the Town's chief building official.

Mr. DeVries said Loblaws officials told him that the store had a tight construction schedule to meet. He added that the fine is significant, even for such a large company.


"This fine has a deterrent attached to it," he said. "Fifteen thousand dollars is still \$15,000. It's a lot of money."

The new 57,000-square-metre store is slated to open September 1.
